

State Medical Board of Ohio
Formal Action Report – October 2011

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Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the State Medical Board of Ohio in October 2011 and an update of Board matters pending or decided in courts as of October 13, 2011.

PRE-HEARING SUSPENSIONS

ALBERS, Henry William, M.D. (#35-074754) – Dayton, Ohio

Pursuant to Section 4731.22(I), O.R.C., medical license automatically suspended as of 7/6/11 based on doctor's having been found guilty in the Greene County Court of Common Pleas on two felony counts of Sexual Battery and one felony count of Gross Sexual Imposition. Notice mailed 10/13/11.

CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS

ALBERS, Henry William, M.D. (#35-074754) – Dayton, Ohio

Based on doctor's conviction in the Greene County Court of Common Pleas on two felony counts of Sexual Battery and one felony count of Gross Sexual Imposition. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 10/13/11.

DRAKE, Miles Edward, Jr., M.D. (#35-047457) – Canal Winchester, Ohio

Based on doctor's alleged violation of conditions of limitation imposed on certificate by 6/14/06 consent agreement, including failing to provide quarterly declarations, logs of controlled substances prescribed, urine screening reports, documentary evidence of participation in alcohol and drug rehabilitation meetings, and failing to obtain Board approval of required courses and a monitoring physician. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed on 10/13/11.

KNORR, Lana Therese, M.T. (#33-019131) – Springboro, Ohio

Massage therapist notified of right to request a hearing on the question of whether her failure to submit to a mental or physical examination as ordered by the Board was due to

circumstances beyond her control. Based on the legal presumption that applicant's failure to submit to a mental or physical examination as ordered by the Board constitutes admission of the legal and factual allegations demonstrating that applicant is impaired in the ability to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care by reason of mental or physical illness. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 10/13/11.

FINAL ORDERS

BLOCKER, David C., M.D. (#35-061188) – Dayton, Ohio

No further action taken. Based on Board's finding that doctor's violation of conditions of limitation placed on medical license by 9/13/06 consent agreement due to doctor having been found guilty of Disorderly Conduct, did not warrant additional discipline. Order effective 11/2/11.

BOWERS, Walter Thomas, II, M.D. (#35-039566) – Cincinnati, Ohio

Doctor reprimanded and medical license placed on probation for at least two years. Based on prior action by the Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure which issued an Agreed Order limiting doctor from practicing obstetrics and performing any obstetric procedure in the state of Kentucky for a period of five years. Order effective 10/13/11.

BRUMFIELD, Daniel H., M.D. (#35-090980) – Beavercreek, Ohio

Medical license permanently revoked. Based on doctor's violation of the AMA Code of Ethics by structuring the operations of a pain management clinic that is owned by non-physicians to require each pain patient to bring as a condition for treatment another patient who is not seeking treatment for pain, prescribing Suboxone for opioid addiction without having the required DEA registration, submitting a prescription benefit coverage form upon which he provided false information, and providing false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading information to the Medical Board, all of which violate the conditions of limitation placed on doctor's medical license by the 1/9/08 Consent Agreement. Order effective 11/2/11.

EDGE, Stephen Leon, M.D. (#35-068958) – Atlanta, Georgia

Medical license revoked. Based on prior action by the Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure indefinitely restricting doctor's Kentucky medical license and conditioning the resumption of practice upon doctor's successful completion of an approved residency program, the underlying basis being doctor's practice below the minimal standards of care and failure to maintain medical records, and doctor's making a false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statement on his 12/22/09 Ohio licensure renewal application by failing to disclose the Kentucky action. Order effective 11/2/11.

HOBSON, Rachel RuthAnn, M.T. (#33-014485) – Russellville, Ohio

Massage therapy license permanently revoked. Based on massage therapist having been diagnosed with alcohol abuse and marijuana abuse and found to be impaired in ability to practice by a Board-approved provider, and on her making a false, fraudulent, deceptive,

or misleading statement in securing or attempting to secure a massage therapy license by failing to disclose her convictions of criminal damaging and two DUIs. Order effective 10/13/11. (Review and Journal Entry – no hearing requested.)

WALTER, Michelle Marie (MT Applicant) – North Royalton, Ohio
Application for massage therapy license granted and immediately suspended for an indefinite period of time with interim monitoring conditions, conditions for reinstatement, and probationary conditions for at least five years established. Based on applicant's impairment of ability to practice massage therapy according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care due to diagnosis of alcohol abuse. Order effective 10/13/11.

WANGLER, Mark Adrian, M.D. (#35-048180) – Lima, Ohio
Medical license permanently revoked. Based on doctor having been found guilty in the Allen County Court of Common Pleas on one felony count of Aggravated Murder. Order effective 10/13/11.

YAMOUR, Adil Younis, M.D. (#35-047500) – Mount Sterling, Ohio
Medical license placed on probation for at least three years. Based on Board's finding that doctor failed to maintain minimal standards of care applicable to the selection or administration of drugs and departed from the minimal standards of care. Order effective 11/2/11.

CONSENT AGREEMENTS

KANG, Kavita A. J., D.O. (#58-004159) – Dayton, Ohio

Training certificate suspended for indefinite period of time; interim monitoring conditions and conditions for reinstatement established, including requirement that doctor enter into subsequent consent agreement incorporating probationary terms, conditions and limitations to monitor practice. Based on doctor's admissions that she is impaired due to mental illness and alcohol dependence, for which she has sought treatment through a Board-approved provider. Agreement effective 10/12/2011.

MISHLER, William George, M.D. (#35-036263) – Reno, Nevada

Doctor reprimanded and medical license placed on probation for at least three years. Based on prior action by the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners, the underlying basis of which was that doctor allegedly performed wrong-site surgery in that he operated on a patient's right ring finger rather than the patient's right long trigger finger. Agreement effective 10/12/11.

MARCINOW, Anna Maria, M.D. (#57-017018) – Columbus, Ohio

Training certificate suspended for at least 180 days; interim monitoring conditions and conditions for reinstatement established, including requirement that doctor enter into subsequent consent agreement incorporating probationary terms, conditions and limitations to monitor practice. Based on doctor's admissions that she is impaired due to chemical dependence, for which she has sought treatment through a Board-approved provider and that she obtained Adderall by writing prescriptions in her name but used other physicians' names as the prescribers without those physicians' knowledge or consent. Agreement effective 10/12/11.

FLANIGAN, Jackson L. J., M.D. (#35-061527) – Cambridge, Ohio

Medical license suspended for at least 90 days; interim monitoring conditions and conditions for reinstatement established, including requirement that doctor enter into subsequent consent agreement incorporating probationary terms, conditions and limitations to monitor practice. Based on doctor's admission that he is impaired due to alcohol dependence, for which he has sought treatment through a Board-approved provider. Agreement effective 10/12/11.

LICENSE REINSTATED

HOBOWSKY, Martin Richard, D.O. (#34-006544) – South Charleston, Ohio

Doctor's request for reinstatement approved by vote of the Board on 10/12/11, subject to probationary terms, conditions, and limitations established by 4/14/10, consent agreement.

REINGLASS, James Lowell, M.D. (#35-031883) – Canton, Ohio

Doctor's request for reinstatement approved by vote of the Board on 10/12/11, subject to probationary terms, conditions, and limitations established by 6/8/11, Board Order.

VOLUNTARY SURRENDERS/RETIREMENTS

ADRION, William Robert, M.D. (#35-0026584) – Columbus, Ohio

Doctor's voluntary retirement of medical license accepted by the Board in lieu of formal disciplinary proceedings based on doctor's inability to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care due to physical impairment; doctor ineligible for licensure in the future. Effective 10/12/11.

PATTERSON, Steven Todd, D.O. (#34-005118) – Tampa, Florida

Doctor's permanent voluntary surrender of medical license accepted by Board in lieu of continued monitoring under the terms, limitations and conditions of 8/12/09 consent

agreement based on allegations of mental or physical impairment; doctor permanently ineligible for reinstatement or issuance of any other certificate issued by Board. Effective 10/12/11.

MOTHKUR, Venkat K., M.D. (#57-018734) – Cincinnati, Ohio

Doctor's surrender of training certificate accepted by Board in lieu of further formal disciplinary proceedings. Based on doctor's admission that he is impaired in his ability to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care due to his diagnoses of alcohol dependence/withdrawal/intoxication, generalized anxiety disorder and major depressive disorder. Effective 10/12/11.

YANG, Han Mok, M.D. (#35-038860) – Dayton, Ohio

Permanent revocation of medical license authorized by doctor in lieu of further investigation related to doctor's alleged failure to maintain minimal standards applicable to the selection or administration of drugs; selling, giving away, personally furnishing, prescribing, or administering drugs for other than legal and legitimate therapeutic purposes; and failure to maintain minimal standards of care. Effective 10/12/11.

Doctor's request for approval of monitoring physician granted by the Board on 10/13/11. Frequency and number of charts to be reviewed by monitoring physician established.

Doctor's request for approval of assessor for purposes of reinstatement granted by the Board on 10/13/11.
