



The requirements for licensure as a dietitian in Ohio are described in Section 4759.06 to 4759.061 of the Ohio Revised Code.

An Initial license is available for individuals meeting academic, pre-professional and examination requirements. The current examination approved by the Board is the examination offered by the Commission on Dietetic Registration for dietitians.

A Limited Permit license is available for individuals who have met academic and pre-professional requirements and are planning to sit for the next available examination. The following fees must be submitted with the application:

Limited Permit License	\$65.00
Initial License or Reactivation	\$125.00
Prorated Initial License (April 1-June 30 only)	\$62.50
Reinstatement	\$180.00
Annual Renewal	\$95.00

Beginning 3/24/2008 all first-time applicants for a license in Ohio must complete a criminal background check pursuant to ORC 4759.061. Applicants should follow the BCI Background Record Check instructions on our website to complete the required criminal background check.
