Staggered Renewal Schedule and Requirements

Define “staggered renewal”:

“Staggered renewal” is a method of shifting Ohio Cosmetic Therapist license expiration dates from a single date of expiration for all licensees to variable expiration dates based upon the first letter of the licensee’s last name. The staggered renewal method provides funding for the Medical Board on a continual basis as contrasted to biennial funding.

Initial Licensure and Expiration Date:

The initial application fee a Cosmetic Therapist pays to cover the cost of processing the application and issuing a certificate. Once a certificate is issued, a Cosmetic Therapist may practice without paying a further fee until their renewal group is required to renew. The time period before a Cosmetic Therapist is required to renew will vary, sometimes significantly, depending on when the license is issued and when your renewal group is required to renew. The chart below indicates when the renewal application is generated for each renewal group.

Name Changes:

The licensee’s renewal group will be based upon the first letter of their last name at the time of their initial license. Should there be a name change; the licensee will remain in their originally assigned group for all subsequent license renewals.

Continuing Education Requirements and Prorated Table

Continuing Cosmetic Therapy Education (CCTE) requirements:

The table below summarizes the CTCE cycle and the number of CTCE hours required along with a prorated table example for those licenses issued within the cycle.

Prorated Table Example per OAC 4731-1-08 (K)(1)(2)(3)

CT license or Restoration issued:	Total Required CCTE Credit Hours
Prior to the first day of the second year of the registration period	12.5
On or after the first day of the second year, prior to the 18 th month of that period	6
On or after the first day of the 18 th month of the registration period	0
