PERMANENT SURRENDER OF CERTIFICATE
TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY**

I, Victor E. Fuchs, M.T., am aware of my rights to representation by counsel, the right of being formally charged and having a formal adjudicative hearing, and do hereby freely execute this document and choose to take the actions described herein.

I, Victor E. Fuchs, M.T., do hereby voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently surrender my certificate to practice massage therapy, No. 33-005557, to the State Medical Board of Ohio, thereby relinquishing all rights to practice massage therapy in Ohio.

I understand that as a result of the surrender herein that I am no longer permitted to practice massage therapy in any form or manner in the State of Ohio.

I agree that I shall be ineligible for, and shall not apply for, reinstatement of certificate to practice massage therapy No. 33-005557 or issuance of any other certificate pursuant to Chapters 4730., 4731., 4760. or 4762., Ohio Revised Code, on or after the date of signing this Permanent Surrender of Certificate to Practice Massage Therapy. Any such attempted reapplication shall be considered null and void and shall not be processed by the Board.

I, Victor E. Fuchs, M.T., hereby release the State Medical Board of Ohio, its members, employees, agents and officers, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the within matter.

This document shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code, and shall constitute an order of the Board upon acceptance by the Secretary and Supervising Member of the Board. Further, this information may be reported to appropriate organizations, data banks and governmental bodies.

I state that in or about April 2000, in the Franklin County Municipal Court, I was charged by complaint with two counts of violation of Section 2907.06(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code, Sexual Imposition, a sex offense and misdemeanor of the third degree. I further state that said complaints were amended, by agreement of the parties, to charge one count of violation of Section 2909.07, Ohio Revised Code, Criminal Mischief, a property offense and misdemeanor of the third degree. I further state that in November 2000, in the Franklin County Municipal Court, I entered a plea of guilty to the amended charge of violation of Section 2909.07, Ohio Revised Code, Criminal Mischief.

I further state that I am taking the action described herein in lieu of formal disciplinary proceedings pursuant to Section 4731.22, Ohio Revised Code, based upon my plea of




