
Entry of Order

In consideration of the foregoing and of Doctor Coan's express waiver of the provision of Section 4731.22(B), Ohio Revised Code, requiring that six (6) Board Members vote to revoke said certificate, it is hereby ORDERED that Certificate No. 0436 authorizing James E. Coan, D.O., to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery be and is hereby REVOKED.

This Order is hereby entered upon the Journal of the State Medical Board for the 15th day of April, 1988, and the original thereof shall be kept with said Journal.

VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF CERTIFICATE
TO PRACTICE OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY

I, JAMES E. COAN, D.O., am aware of my rights to representation by counsel, the right of being formally charged and having a formal adjudicative hearing, and do hereby freely execute this document and choose to take the actions described herein.

I, JAMES E. COAN, D.O., do hereby voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently surrender my certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, NO. 0436, to the Ohio State Medical Board.

I understand that as a result of the surrender herein that I am no longer permitted to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in any form or manner in the State of Ohio.

I agree that I shall be ineligible for, and shall not apply for, reinstatement of certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery No. 0436, or issuance of any other certificate pursuant to Chapters 4730. and 4731., Ohio Revised Code, on or after the date of signing this Voluntary Surrender of Certificate to Practice Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery.

I hereby authorize the State Medical Board of Ohio to enter upon its Journal an Order revoking my certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, No. 0436, in conjunction with which I expressly waive the provision of Section 4731.22(B), Ohio Revised Code, requiring that six (6) Board Members vote to revoke said certificate, and further expressly and forever waive all rights as set forth in Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, including but not limited to my right to counsel, right to a hearing, right to present evidence, right to cross-examine witnesses, and right to appeal the Order of the Board revoking my certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery.

I stipulate and agree that I am taking the action described herein in lieu of formal disciplinary proceedings pursuant to Section 4731.22(B) (3), Ohio Revised Code.
