FINDINGS, ORDER AND JOURNAL ENTRY

This matter came on for consideration after a citation letter was mailed to Stephen W. Kramer by the State Medical Board of Ohio on December 12, 1994.

By letter dated December 12, 1994, notice was given to Doctor Kramer that the State Medical Board intended to consider disciplinary action regarding his license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in Ohio, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice. In accordance with Section 119.09, Ohio Revised Code, said notice was sent via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of Stephen W. Kramer, that being 5512 Lansury Lane, Lyndhurst, OH, 44124.

Doctor Kramer responded to the Board's notice and requested a hearing in a timely manner, but such request was withdrawn by the doctor on February 10, 1995.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons outlined in the December 12, 1994 letter of notice, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Stephen W. Kramer, DO to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio be PERMANENTLY REVOKED

This Order shall become effective IMMEDIATELY.





NOTICE OF IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

Dear Doctor Kramer:

In accordance with Section 2929.17 and/or 3719.12(B), Ohio Revised Code, the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney of Cuyahoga County, Ohio reported that on or about August 18, 1994, in the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas, you pleaded guilty to three (3) felony counts of Trafficking in drugs in violation of Section 2925.03, Ohio Revised Code.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 3719.121(C), Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that your license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio is immediately suspended. Continued practice after this suspension shall be considered practicing without a certificate in violation of Section 4731.41, Ohio Revised Code.

Furthermore, in accordance with Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) On or about August 18, 1994, in the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas, you pleaded guilty to three (3) felony counts of trafficking in drugs in violation of Section 2925.03, Ohio Revised Code.

Your guilty plea as alleged in paragraph (1) above constitutes "(s)elling, prescribing, giving away, or administering drugs for other than legal and legitimate therapeutic purposes or a plea of guilty to, or a judicial finding of guilt of, a violation of any federal or state law regulating the possession, distribution, or use of any drug," as those clauses are used in Section 4731.22(B)(3), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your guilty plea as alleged in paragraph (1) above constitutes "(a) plea of guilty to, or a judicial finding of guilt of, a felony," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. 
