

CONSENT AGREEMENT

THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT IS entered into by and between JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapters 4730. and 4731. of the Ohio Revised Code.

JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., enters into this Agreement being fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel.

This Agreement is entered into on the basis of the following statements, admissions and understandings:

1. JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., admits that on December 28, 1982 the Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners of Florida, by final order, suspended his license to practice osteopathic medicine in that state and that said suspension was stayed.
2. JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., further admits that pursuant to the order of December 28, 1982 he was placed on probation under the following terms:
 - a. that he not seek return of his Schedule II DEA permit nor use said permit;
 - b. that he appear semi-annually before the Florida Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners;
 - c. that said probation would be for a period of two (2) years.
3. Further, JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., admits that by order entered August 29, 1983 the Florida Board returned his Schedule II DEA privileges and continued his probation under the original terms and conditions.


WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO hereby CONSENT and AGREE to the following terms and conditions of limitation upon his license to practice medicine and surgery in Ohio:

- A. THE OHIO STATE MEDICAL BOARD agrees to approve JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O.'s application for reinstatement of his license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in Ohio.
- B. JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., agrees to be placed on probation until at least the January, 1985 OHIO STATE MEDICAL BOARD meeting.
- C. JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., further agrees that he will appear before the full BOARD at the January, 1985 meeting.
- D. THE OHIO STATE MEDICAL BOARD may release JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., from probation at the January, 1985 BOARD meeting if the Florida Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners has released him from probation.

If, in the discretion of the Secretary of the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, JOHN GUSTIN, JR., D.O., appears to have violated or breached any terms or conditions of this Agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches of this Agreement and any alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before or after the effective date of this Agreement.


Upon consent of both parties, the terms and conditions of this Agreement may be modified or terminated in writing.
