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FINDINGS, ORDER, AND JOURNAL ENTRY

This matter came on for consideration after a citation letter was issued to Russell Crispell, D.O., by the Ohio State Medical Board on February 25, 1985.

On February 25, 1985 notice was given to Russell Crispell, D.O., that the State Medical Board of Ohio intended to consider disciplinary action regarding his license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in Ohio, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice. Dr. Crispell has not requested a hearing, and thirty (30) days have elapsed since the mailing of the aforesaid notice.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that for the reasons outlined in the February 25, 1985 letter of notice which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, accordingly, the license of Russell Crispell, D.O. to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in Ohio be REVOKED.

This Order shall become effective on the 11th day of June, 1985.

Dear Doctor Crispell:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine under the provisions of Section 4731.22, Ohio Revised Code, whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation, for one or more of the following reasons:

1. On or about May 23, 1983, you were convicted in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, in Docket Number 82-00416-01 of two (2) counts of mail fraud, in violation of Title 18 U.S.C. Section 1341, both said counts constituting felonies. The acts committed by you on which said convictions were based occurred in the course of your practice as a Doctor of Osteopathy.

The above acts committed by you, individually and/or collectively, constitute "the obtaining of, or attempting to obtain, money or anything of value by fraudulent misrepresentations in the course of practice," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(8), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, the above convictions, individually and/or collectively, constitute "conviction of a felony whether or not committed in the course of practice", as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are entitled to a hearing on this matter. If you wish to request such a hearing, that request must be made within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

In the event there is no request for such hearing made within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board of Ohio may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation.
