**SURRENDER OF CERTIFICATE
TO PRACTICE OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY**

I, MICHAEL RAY CARPENTER, D.O., am aware of my rights to representation by counsel, the right of being formally charged and having a formal adjudicative hearing, and do hereby freely execute this document and choose to take the actions described herein.

I, MICHAEL RAY CARPENTER, D.O., do hereby voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently surrender my certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, No. 34-002360, to the State Medical Board of Ohio, thereby relinquishing all rights to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in Ohio.

I understand that as a result of the surrender herein that I am no longer permitted to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in any form or manner in the State of Ohio.

I agree that I shall be ineligible for, and shall not apply for, reinstatement of certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery No. 34-002360 or issuance of any other certificate pursuant to Chapters 4730. or 4731., Ohio Revised Code, on or after the date of signing this Surrender of Certificate to Practice Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery. Any such attempted reapplication shall be considered null and void and shall not be processed by the Board.

I hereby authorize the State Medical Board of Ohio to enter upon its Journal an Order revoking my certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, No. 34-002360, in conjunction with which I expressly waive the provision of Section 4731.22(B), Ohio Revised Code, requiring that six (6) Board Members vote to revoke said certificate, and further expressly and forever waive all rights as set forth in Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, including but not limited to my right to counsel, right to a hearing, right to present evidence, right to cross-examine witnesses, and right to appeal the Order of the Board revoking my certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery.

I, MICHAEL RAY CARPENTER, D.O., hereby release the State Medical Board of Ohio, its members, employees, agents and officers, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the within matter.

This document shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code.

Further, this information may be reported to appropriate organizations, data banks and governmental bodies.

I stipulate and agree that I am taking the action described herein in lieu of formal disciplinary proceedings pursuant to Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code, based upon my plea of guilty in the Court of Common Pleas, Summit County, State of Ohio, to eleven (11) counts of violating Section 2925.03(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code, Drug trafficking, as described in the plea agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein.

THIS DAY, to-wit: The 8th day of May, A.D., 1996, now comes the Prosecuting Attorney on behalf of the State of Ohio, the Defendant, MICHAEL R. CARPENTER, being in Court with counsel, JIM BURDON, and said Defendant was fully advised of his Constitutional rights and his rights as required under Rule 11 of the Ohio Rules of Criminal Procedure.

Thereupon, said Defendant retracts his plea of Not Guilty heretofore entered, and for plea to said Indictment, says he is GUILTY of the charge of TRAFFICKING IN DRUGS, as contained in Counts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 of the Indictment, Ohio Revised Code Section 2925.03(A)(1), felonies of the fourth (4th) degree with the SPECIFICATION OF CRIMINAL FORFEITURE, which pleas, voluntarily made, and with a full understanding of the consequences, are accepted by the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant surrenders his license to practice osteopathic medicine.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this case be referred to the Adult Probation Department for a pre-sentence investigation and report, and the Defendant was released on the same bond which was continued to await sentencing set for June 3, 1996 at 2:00 P.M.
