
Dear Doctor Boyle:



FINDINGS, ORDER, AND JOURNAL ENTRY

This matter came on for consideration after a citation letter was issued to John F. Boyle, Jr., D.O., by the State Medical Board of Ohio on July 11, 1990.

On July 11, 1990 notice was given to Dr. Boyle that the State Medical Board intended to consider disciplinary action regarding his license to practice medicine and surgery in Ohio, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice. In accordance with Section 119.09, Ohio Revised Code, said notice was sent via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of Dr. Boyle, that being P.O. Box 1723, Mansfield, Ohio, 44901.


No request for hearing has been received and thirty (30) days have elapsed since the mailing of the aforesaid notice.



Dear Doctor Boyle:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) On or about June 29, 1990, you were found guilty in the Richland County Ohio Common Pleas Court, of abuse of a corpse, a felony, in violation of Section 2927.01(B), Ohio Revised Code.

Such acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "a plea of guilty to, or a judicial finding of guilt of, a felony," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before the agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

NOTICE OF AUTOMATIC SUSPENSION

Dear Doctor Boyle:

Pursuant to Section 4731.22(F), Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that your license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio has been automatically suspended as of June 29, 1990, by operation of law. Continued practice after this suspension shall be considered practicing medicine without a certificate.

Furthermore, in accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation on the grounds that on or about June 29, 1990, you were found guilty in the Richland County Ohio Common Pleas Court, of aggravated murder, a felony, which constitutes a violation of Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.


You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before the agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.
