
ENTRY OF ORDER

On October 1, 2001, Maynard G. Muntzing, II, D.O., executed a Voluntary Surrender of his Certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio with a consent to revocation, which document is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein.

In consideration of the foregoing and of Dr. Muntzing's express waiver of the provision of Section 4731.22(B), Ohio Revised Code, requiring that six (6) Board members vote to revoke said certificate, it is hereby ORDERED that Certificate No. 34-006509 authorizing Maynard G. Muntzing, II, D.O., to practice osteopathic medicine be permanently REVOKED, effective October 2, 2001.

This Order is hereby entered upon the Journal of the State Medical Board of Ohio for the 2nd day of October, 2001, and the original thereof shall be kept with said Journal.

**SURRENDER OF CERTIFICATE TO PRACTICE
OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY**

I, MAYNARD G. MUNTZING, II, D.O., am aware of my rights to representation by counsel, the right of being formally charged and having a formal adjudicative hearing, and do hereby freely execute this document and choose to take the actions described herein.

I, MAYNARD G. MUNTZING, II, D.O., do hereby voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently surrender my Certificate to Practice Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery, No. 34-006509, to the State Medical Board of Ohio, thereby relinquishing all rights to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in Ohio.

I understand that as a result of the surrender herein I am no longer permitted to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in any form or manner in the State of Ohio. This Surrender of Certificate to Practice Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery shall be effective upon the last date of signature below.

I agree that I shall be ineligible for, and shall not apply for, reinstatement of certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery No. 34-006509, or issuance of any other certificate pursuant to Chapters 4730., 4731., 4760. or 4762., Ohio Revised Code, on or after the date of signing this Surrender of Certificate to Practice Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery. Any such attempted reapplication shall be considered null and void and shall not be processed by the Board.

I hereby authorize the State Medical Board of Ohio to enter upon its Journal an Order permanently revoking my certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, No. 34-006509, in conjunction with which I expressly waive the provision of Section 4731.22(B), Ohio Revised Code, requiring that six (6) Board Members vote to revoke said certificate, and further expressly and forever waive all rights as set forth in Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, including but not limited to my right to counsel, right to a hearing, right to present evidence, right to cross-examine witnesses, and right to appeal the Order of the Board revoking my certificate to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery.

I, MAYNARD G. MUNTZING, II, D.O, hereby release the State Medical Board of Ohio, its members, employees, agents and officers, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the within matter.

I stipulate and agree that I am taking the action described herein in lieu of formal disciplinary proceedings pursuant to Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code, resulting from my having entered a guilty plea on or about ~~September 28, 2001~~, to Counts VIII, XI, and XII of the Indictment in Case Number 00-CR-2387, in the Common Pleas Court of Montgomery County, Ohio, charging me with Contaminating a Substance for Human Consumption, in violation of Section 2927.24(B), Ohio Revised Code, (Counts VIII and XI), being felonies of the first degree; and with Attempted Felonious Assault, in violation of Section 2923.02(A)/2903.11(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code (Count XII), being a felony of the third degree.
