CONSENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
EDWARD R. SCHUMACHER, M.D.  
AND  
THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between EDWARD R. SCHUMACHER, M.D., and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO:

EDWARD R. SCHUMACHER, M.D., enters into this agreement being fully aware of his rights and advised by counsel.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, EDWARD R. SCHUMACHER, M.D., knowingly and voluntarily enters into the following agreement with THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO:

1. EDWARD R. SCHUMACHER, M.D., agrees to abide by the following terms and conditions:
  - A. He will refrain completely from prescribing, administering, ordering, or dispensing any and all controlled substances listed in Schedules II and IIN for a period of six (6) months, said period commencing on the effective date of this agreement.
  - B. He will not apply for reinstatement of his Drug Enforcement Administration (hereinafter DEA) Certificate of Registration for a period of six (6) months, said period commencing on the effective date of this agreement.
  - C. He will notify THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO prior to his application for reinstatement of his DEA Certificate of Registration. Provided that he has satisfactorily conducted his practice during said six (6) month period, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO shall not take any action to oppose his application for the reinstatement of his DEA Certificate of Registration for Schedules II and IIN.
  - D. For a period of six (6) months commencing on the effective date of this agreement, he agrees that, with the exception of bona fide patients, he will employ, or otherwise permit to be present on his office premises on a daily basis, only such persons who are named on a list of employees that he will provide to THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO. He shall provide any additions or alterations to this list to THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, which reserves the right to inquire into the additions or alterations. He will cooperate fully with THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO with respect to such inquiry.

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- E. He will cooperate fully with THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO and its agents and employees, and, when requested, make his place of practice available for inspection.
- F. He will obey all laws, rules, and regulations of the United States, the State of Ohio, and its political subdivisions, related to the practice of medicine.
- G. He will report in person, at approximate three (3) month intervals, to THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, the Secretary of the Board, or its agents and employees, for the purpose of reporting on his current activities.
2. Unless otherwise indicated, each of the foregoing terms and conditions shall be in effect for a period of six (6) months, said period commencing on the effective date of this agreement.
3. If, in the discretion of the Secretary of THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, EDWARD R. SCHUMACHER, M.D., appears to have violated, or breached any terms or conditions of this agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this agreement, including alleged violations contained within the letter of citation issued by THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO to EDWARD R. SCHUMACHER, M.D., on January 9, 1980.

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The terms and conditions of this agreement shall become effective on the 20th day of NOVEMBER, 1980.

Edward R. Schumacher, M.D., being fully aware of his rights, knowingly and voluntarily enters into the following agreement with The State Medical Board of Ohio:


1. Edward R. Schumacher, M.D., agrees to voluntarily surrender his Drug Enforcement Administration (hereinafter DEA) Certificate of Registration as evidence of his agreement with the DEA to relinquish his privilege to handle controlled substances listed in schedules 2 and 2N.
2. Edward R. Schumacher, M.D., agrees not to apply for reinstatement of his DEA Certificate of Registration until January 19, 1980.
3. Edward R. Schumacher, M.D., agrees to notify The State Medical Board of Ohio prior to application for reinstatement of his DEA Certificate of Registration.


The State Medical Board of Ohio, in full and adequate consideration, agrees to these terms and conditions in lieu of initiating formal disciplinary proceedings against Edward R. Schumacher, M.D.

If, in the discretion of the Secretary of The State Medical Board, Edward R. Schumacher, M.D., appears to have violated any terms or conditions of this agreement, The State Medical Board of Ohio reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations.

Upon consent of both parties, the terms of this agreement may be modified or terminated in writing.
