**PERMANENT RETIREMENT FROM THE PRACTICE
OF MEDICINE AND SURGERY AND
PERMANENT SURRENDER OF MEDICAL LICENSE**

I, EDGAR J. REAGAN, M.D., am aware of my rights to representation by counsel, the right of having a formal adjudicative hearing, and do hereby freely execute this document and choose to take the actions described herein, after being fully advised by legal counsel.

I, EDGAR J. REAGAN, M.D., as a result of my retirement from the practice of medicine and surgery, do hereby voluntarily, knowingly, intelligently, and permanently surrender and retire my certificate to practice medicine and surgery, No. 35-014870, to the State Medical Board of Ohio, thereby permanently relinquishing all rights to practice medicine and surgery in Ohio. This retirement and surrender shall be effective as of midnight, November 30, 1998.

I understand that as a result of the retirement and surrender herein that I am no longer permitted to practice medicine and surgery in any form or manner in the State of Ohio.

I agree that I shall be ineligible for, and shall not apply for, reinstatement of certificate to practice medicine and surgery No. 35-014870, or issuance of any other certificate pursuant to Chapters 4730. or 4731., Ohio Revised Code, on or after the date of signing of this Retirement/Surrender of Certificate to Practice Medicine and Surgery. Any such attempted reapplication shall be considered null and void and shall not be processed by the Board.

I stipulate and agree that I am taking the action described herein in lieu of further formal disciplinary proceedings regarding the matters described in the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing dated August 12, 1998.

This document shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code.

Further, this information may be reported to appropriate organizations, data banks and governmental bodies.





Dear Doctor Reagan:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) On 6/26/96, 9/7/96, 11/19/96, 1/9/97, 5/27/97, and 8/5/97, you prescribed 100 Ritalin 20 mg tablets, a Schedule II controlled stimulant, to Patient 1 (as identified on the attached Patient Key - Key Confidential and not subject to public disclosure), by forging the signature of another physician on the prescription blank.
- (2) You initiated this treatment of Patient 1 utilizing a Schedule II controlled stimulant without obtaining a thorough history and performing a thorough physical examination of Patient 1. Further, although you recorded the above-referenced Ritalin prescriptions in your daily pocket calendar, you failed to maintain medical records regarding Patient 1.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "[c]ommission of an act that constitutes a felony in this state regardless of the jurisdiction in which the act was committed," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(10), Ohio Revised Code, to wit: Section 2925.22(A), Ohio Revised Code, Deception to Obtain a Dangerous Drug.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "[c]ommission of an act that constitutes a felony in this state regardless of the jurisdiction in which the act was committed," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(10), Ohio Revised Code, to wit: Section 2925.23, Ohio Revised Code, Illegal Processing of Drug Documents.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (2) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or abetting the violation of, or conspiring to violate, any provisions of this chapter or

any rule promulgated by the board," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(20), Ohio Revised Code, to wit: 4731-11-02(D), Ohio Administrative Code. Pursuant to Rule 4731-11-02(F), Ohio Administrative Code, violation of Rule 4731-11-02(D), Ohio Administrative Code, also violates Sections 4731.22(B)(2) and (6), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (2) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or abetting the violation of, or conspiring to violate, any provisions of this chapter or any rule promulgated by the board," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(20), Ohio Revised Code, to wit: 4731-11-03(C)(1), Ohio Administrative Code. Pursuant to Rule 4731-11-03(D), Ohio Administrative Code, violation of Rule 4731-11-03, Ohio Administrative Code, also violates Sections 4731.22(B)(2), (3) and (6), Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before this agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

In the event that there is no request for such hearing received within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery or to reprimand or place you on probation.
