

CONSENT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

ROBERT B. WALKER, M. D.

AND

THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO

THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT IS entered into by and between ROBERT B. WALKER, M. D. and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapters 4730. and 4731. of the Ohio Revised Code.

ROBERT B. WALKER, M. D. enters into this Agreement being fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel.

This Agreement is entered into on the basis of the following statements, admissions, and understandings:

1. DR. ROBERT B. WALKER admits that he is an alcoholic.
2. DR. ROBERT B. WALKER states that he voluntarily admitted himself to Flower Hospital for treatment.
3. DR. ROBERT B. WALKER further states that he successfully completed the Flower Hospital treatment program.

WHEREAS, ROBERT B. WALKER, M. D. and the BOARD have agreed to enter into this CONSENT AGREEMENT which the parties have resolved to be in their mutual best interests.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, ROBERT B. WALKER, M. D., and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO hereby CONSENT and AGREE to the following terms and conditions:

- A) DR. WALKER agrees to attend Alcoholics Anonymous, I.D.A. or similar support group at least two (2) times per week.
- B) DR. WALKER agrees to appear before the Board or its representative every three (3) months or at such intervals as the Board deems appropriate.
- C) DR. WALKER shall make arrangements with his treating physician, Deirdre O'Connor, M. D., to have reports of his status forwarded to the Board every three (3) months.
- D) DR. WALKER agrees to maintain a drug log reflecting all Controlled Substances prescribed, administered, or dispensed by him. Said log shall contain the following information: Date, patient, substance, quantity, and reason for prescribing, administering, or dispensing said substance.

If, in the discretion of the Secretary of THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, ROBERT B. WALKER, M. D. appears to have violated or breached any terms or conditions of this Agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this Agreement.

Upon consent of both parties, the terms and conditions of this Agreement may be modified or terminated in writing.

The terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement shall become effective upon signing of the parties.

IT IS AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD by and between the parties that this Consent Agreement shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code.
