

CONSENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
ELLIOT MIGDAL, M.D.  
AND  
THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO

THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between ELLIOT MIGDAL, M.D. and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapters 4730. and 4731. of the Ohio Revised Code.

ELLIOT MIGDAL, M.D., enters into this agreement being fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel.

This agreement is entered into on the basis of the following statements, admissions and understandings:

- A. ELLIOT MIGDAL, M.D., entered the Medical Association of Georgia's Impaired Physicians Program on January 26, 1983 for the treatment of his disease of chemical dependency.
- B. ELLIOT MIGDAL, M.D., is currently participating in the aftercare program of this Association.

WHEREAS, in lieu of a formal adjudication hearing, DR. MIGDAL and the BOARD have agreed to enter into this CONSENT AGREEMENT which the parties have resolved to be in their mutual best interests.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, ELLIOT MIGDAL, M.D., and the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO hereby CONSENT and AGREE to the following terms and conditions:

1. DR. MIGDAL shall keep a log of all scheduled drugs he prescribes, dispenses, or administers.
2. DR. MIGDAL shall practice medicine in a structured, salaried position only.
3. DR. MIGDAL shall submit to weekly urine screenings and shall arrange to have a report on such screenings sent to the BOARD.
4. DR. MIGDAL shall arrange to have his psychiatrist and his employer submit evaluations of him to the BOARD every two months.
5. DR. MIGDAL shall appear for informal meetings before the Secretary of the Board, or other representative of the Board, every three months from the effective date of this Consent Agreement.

If, in the discretion of the Secretary of THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, ELLIOT MIGDAL, M.D. appears to have violated or breached any terms or conditions of this agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of the Ohio occurring before the effective date of this agreement.

Upon consent of both parties, the terms and conditions of this agreement may be modified or terminated in writing.

The terms and conditions of this agreement shall become effective on the 28th day of October, 1983.
