
Dear Doctor Cecys:



On March 13, 1991, notice was given to Alfons M. Cecys, M.D., that the State Medical Board proposed to deny his request for restoration of his license to practice medicine and surgery in Ohio, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice, March 14, 1991. In accordance with Section 119.09, Ohio Revised Code, said notice was sent via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of Dr. Cecys, that being 35014 Euclid Avenue, Willoughby, Ohio 44094.


No request for hearing has been received and more than thirty (30) days have elapsed since the mailing of the aforesaid notice.


AFFIDAVIT

Dear Doctor Cecys:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) From on or about January 1, 1980 to on or about August 16, 1990 you practiced medicine or surgery in Ohio without a certificate from the State Medical Board of Ohio.
- (2) From on or about January 1, 1980 to on or about August 16, 1990 you opened or conducted an office or other place for the practice of medicine or surgery in Ohio without a certificate from the State Medical Board of Ohio.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute the "(f)ailure to pay license renewal fees specified in this chapter," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(13) of the Ohio Revised Code from January 1, 1980 to August 26, 1982 and in Section 4731.22(B)(16) of the Ohio Revised Code after August 26, 1982.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraphs (1) and (2) above, individually and/or collectively constitute "(v)iolating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or abetting the violation of, or conspiring to violate, any provisions of this chapter or any rule promulgated by the board," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(17) of the Ohio Revised Code from January 1, 1980 to August 26, 1982 and in Section 4731.22(B)(20) of the Ohio Revised Code after August 26, 1982, to wit: Section 4731.41 of the Ohio Revised Code.

- (3) During the period from on or about August 27, 1982 to on or about August 16, 1990 you billed Blue Cross - Blue Shield of Ohio and U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (Medicare) for services rendered in Ohio without a certificate from the State Medical Board of Ohio.
- (4) From on or about August 27, 1982 to on or about August 16, 1990 you wrote prescriptions for drugs and medicine including controlled substances without a certificate from the State Medical Board of Ohio.

Further, you failed to renew your D.E.A. Certificate subsequent to March 31, 1985.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraphs (3) and (4) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "publishing a false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statement," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(5), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraphs (3) and (4) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "(t)he obtaining of, or attempting to obtain money or anything of value by fraudulent misrepresentations in the course of practice," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(8), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (4) above, as pertains to controlled substances individually and/or collectively constitute "commission of an act that constitutes a felony in this state regardless of the jurisdiction in which the act was committed," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(10) of the Ohio Revised Code after March 16, 1987, to wit: Section 2925.23 of the Ohio Revised Code, Illegal processing of drug documents.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before this agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.


