I, ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D., am aware of my rights to representation by counsel, the right of being formally charged and having a formal adjudicative hearing, and do hereby freely execute this document and choose to take the actions described herein.

I, ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D., do hereby voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently retire from the practice of medicine and surgery, effective upon last date of signature below.

I, ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D., do hereby voluntarily, knowingly and intelligently surrender my renewal card in connection with my certificate to practice medicine and surgery, No. 35-019578, to the State Medical Board of Ohio.

I understand that as a result of the surrender herein that I am no longer permitted to practice medicine and surgery in any form or manner in the State of Ohio.

I agree that I shall be ineligible for, and shall not apply for, reinstatement of certificate to practice medicine and surgery No. 35-019578 or issuance of any other certificate pursuant to Chapters 4730. or 4731., Ohio Revised Code, on or after the date of signing this Voluntary Retirement from the Practice of Medicine and Surgery. Any such attempted reapplication shall be considered null and void and shall not be processed by the Board. This Voluntary Retirement supersedes, and serves as resolution of all obligations arising from, the December 8, 1995, Consent Agreement between Robert L. Reinhart, M.D. and the State Medical Board of Ohio.

I, ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D., hereby release the State Medical Board of Ohio, its members, employees, agents and officers, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the within matter.

This document shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code.

Further, this information may be reported to appropriate organizations, data banks and governmental bodies.

I stipulate and agree that I am taking the action described herein based upon my physical illness which has affected my motor skills.

**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D.
AND
THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO**

THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4731., Ohio Revised Code.

ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. enters into this Agreement being fully informed of his rights under Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudicative hearing on the issues considered herein.

This Consent Agreement is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

- A. THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO is empowered by Section 4731.22(B)(15), Ohio Revised Code, to limit, revoke, suspend a certificate, refuse to register or reinstate an applicant, or reprimand or place on probation the holder of a certificate for a "violation of the conditions of limitation placed by the board upon a certificate to practice or violation of the conditions of limitation upon which a limited or temporary registration or certificate to practice is issued."
- B. THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO enters into this Consent Agreement in lieu of further formal disciplinary proceedings based upon the violation of Section 4731.22(B)(15) as detailed in Paragraphs D and E below, and expressly reserves the right to institute formal proceedings based upon any other violations of Chapter 4731. of the Revised Code, whether occurring before or after the effective date of this Agreement.
- C. ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. is licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio, with certificate number 019578.
- D. ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. ADMITS that on October 6, 1989, he entered into a Consent Agreement with the State Medical Board of Ohio in which he agreed to submit within thirty (30) days after the end of each of the next three (3) biennial registration periods following the effective date of the Agreement, documentation acceptable to the Board of satisfactory completion of the requisite hours of continuing medical education.
- E. ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. ADMITS that he had not submitted this documentation in a timely manner, and, in fact, failed to submit documentation for the 1992-94 biennial registration period until after he received the September

6, 1995 notice of opportunity for hearing from the Board notifying him of its intention to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate his certificate to practice medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place him on probation.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of further formal disciplinary proceedings at this time, ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. knowingly and voluntarily agrees with THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, (hereinafter BOARD), to the following PROBATIONARY terms, conditions and limitations:

1. ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Ohio;

2. Within thirty (30) days after the end of each of the next three (3) biennial registration periods following the effective date of this agreement, ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D., shall personally deliver documentation acceptable to the BOARD of satisfactory completion of the requisite hours of continuing medical education, and failure to do so may subject him to the initiation of further disciplinary action without further BOARD contact;

3. Should ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. elect not to renew his Ohio certificate to practice medicine and surgery during the duration of this consent agreement, ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. shall notify the BOARD in writing. Periods of time during which ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D. does not maintain his license as current will not apply to the reduction of the three (3) biennial registration periods for which documentation must be submitted.

If, in the discretion of the Secretary and Supervising Member of THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D., appears to have violated or breached any term or condition of this Agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this Agreement.

ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D., acknowledges that he has had an opportunity to ask questions concerning the terms of this Agreement and that all questions asked have been answered in a satisfactory manner.

Any action initiated by the BOARD based on alleged violations of this Consent Agreement shall comply with the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code.

ROBERT L. REINHART, M.D., hereby releases THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, its Members, Employees, Agents, Officers and

Representatives jointly and severally from any and all liability arising from the within matter.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code. It is expressly understood that this CONSENT AGREEMENT is subject to ratification by the BOARD prior to signature by the Secretary and Supervising Member and shall become effective upon the last date of signature below.





Dear Doctor Reinhart:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) On or about October 26, 1989, you entered into a Consent Agreement with the State Medical Board of Ohio, in which you admitted to certifying that you had completed the requisite hours of Continuing Medical Education (CME) for the preceding biennium when, in fact, you had not done so at the time. A copy of the Consent Agreement is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein.

This agreement required you to submit CME documentation acceptable to the Board of satisfactory completion of the requisite hours for the next three biennial registration periods. This submission was to be within thirty (30) days of the end of the registration period.

Your report for the July 1, 1992-September 30, 1994, biennium was due to the Board by October 31, 1994.

However, you submitted documentation of only 18 of the 40 hours of Category I CME. Thus, you failed to submit documentation acceptable to the Board of satisfactory completion of the requisite hours of CME.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute a "(v)iolation of the conditions of limitation placed by the board upon a certificate to practice or violation of the conditions of limitation upon which a limited or temporary registration or certificate to practice is issued," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(15), Ohio Revised Code.

- (2) On or about March 30, 1994, in applying for renewal of the registration of your Certificate to Practice Medicine or Surgery, you certified that during the registration period of July 1, 1992-September 30, 1994, you completed the requisite hours of CME as required by Section 4731.281, Ohio Revised Code.

In fact, you completed only 18 of the 40 Category I hours of the required CME for that period.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (2) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "fraud, misrepresentation, or deception in applying for or securing any license or certificate issued by the board," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(A), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (2) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "publishing a false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statement," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(5), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, such failure to obtain the requisite CME constitutes "violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or abetting the violation of, or conspiring to violate, any provisions of this chapter or any rule promulgated by the board," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(20), Ohio Revised Code, to wit: Section 4731.281, Ohio Revised Code.

Further, "Failure of any certificate holder to register and comply with this section (Continuing medical education) shall operate automatically to suspend his certificate to practice on the first day of October in the year registration is required (here October 1, 1994) and the continued practice after the suspension shall be considered as practicing without a license." Section 4731.281, Ohio Revised Code. Thus, your license in Ohio was automatically suspended October 1, 1994.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before this agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.





This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. R.L. REINHART M.D. ADMITS that in completing his/her renewal application card for registration of his/her certificate to practice medicine or surgery for the 1987-1988 biennial registration period, he/she did certify that he/she completed during the preceeding biennium the requisite hours of continuing medical education, as required by Section 4731.281, Revised Code.
2. R.L. REINHART M.D. ADMITS that, in fact, he/she had not completed the requisite hours of continuing medical education as required by Section 4731.281, Revised Code, at the time of certification, but did complete the requisite hours subsequently.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal proceedings at this time, R.L. REINHART, M.D. knowingly and voluntarily agrees with THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO to the following conditions and limitations:

- A. That within thirty (30) days after the end of each of the next three (3) biennial registration periods following the effective date of this agreement, R.L. REINHART M.D. shall submit documentation acceptable to the Board of satisfactory completion of the requisite hours of continuing medical education.
- B. That should R.L. REINHART, M.D. elect not to renew his/her Ohio license during the duration of this agreement, R.L. REINHART, M.D. shall notify the BOARD in writing. Periods of time during which R.L. REINHART, M.D. does not maintain his license as current will not apply to the reduction of the three (3) biennial registration periods for which documentation must be submitted.
