FINDINGS, ORDER AND JOURNAL ENTRY

This matter came on for consideration after a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing was mailed to Nathan Harry Carpenter, M.D., by the State Medical Board of Ohio on October 10, 1996 and December 18, 1996.

By letter dated October 9, 1996, notice was given to Nathan Harry Carpenter, M.D., that the State Medical Board intended to consider disciplinary action regarding his license to practice medicine and surgery in Ohio, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice. In accordance with Section 119.07, Ohio Revised Code, said notice was sent via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of Nathan Harry Carpenter, M.D., that being 2601 N.E. 35th Drive. After the notice was returned marked as being unclaimed, Board staff sent a letter to Dr. Carpenter via regular mail advising him that the notice would be published in the newspaper if a second attempt at service were refused. The notice was subsequently remailed on December 18, 1996 via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the same address, and service was obtained.

Dr. Carpenter responded to the Board's notice by letter dated December 19, 1996 and received in the Medical Board's offices on December 23, 1996, but he did not request a hearing. More than (30) days have now elapsed since the last mailing of the aforesaid notice.


WHEREFORE, for the reasons outlined in the October 9, 1996 Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein,



Dear Doctor Carpenter:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

(1) On or about March 9, 1996, you signed the application for renewal of your certificate to practice medicine in Ohio, certifying that the information provided on the application is "true and correct in every respect."

(a) You responded "No" to the question:

At any time since signing your last application for renewal of your certificate have you:

...

5.) Had any disciplinary action taken or initiated against you by any state licensing board other than the State Medical Board of Ohio?

In fact, on or about July 26, 1994, the Board of Medicine, Agency for Health Care Administration, State of Florida (hereinafter, Florida Board) initiated disciplinary action against you by the filing of an Administrative Complaint. On or about June 30, 1995, the Final Order in the case was filed, placing your Florida license to practice medicine on a three year probation, and imposing certain other conditions and limitations on your license.

(b) Further, you responded "No" to the question:

At any time since signing your last application for renewal of your certificate have you:

- ...
- 6) Surrendered, or consented to limitation upon: a) A license to practice medicine; OR b) State or federal privileges to prescribe controlled substances?

In fact, on or about June 30, 1995, the Florida Board, by its filing of the Final Order, adopted and amended the Consent Agreement signed by you on or about April 21, 1995. This Consent Agreement, as amended, placed your Florida license on probation, required that you practice under indirect supervision with monitoring, and prohibited you from prescribing Schedules II through IV controlled substances.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "fraud, misrepresentation, or deception in applying for or securing any license or certificate issued by the board," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(A), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "publishing a false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statement," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(5), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "(t)he obtaining of, or attempting to obtain, money or anything of value by fraudulent misrepresentations in the course of practice," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(8), Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before this agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that



at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

In the event that there is no request for such hearing received within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery or to reprimand or place you on probation.


