

**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
MILAN J. PACKOVICH, M.D.
AND
THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO**

THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between MILAN J. PACKOVICH, M.D. and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4730. and 4731. of the Ohio Revised Code.

Milan J. Packovich M.D., enters into this Agreement being fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel.

WHEREAS, in lieu of a formal adjudication hearing, DR. PACKOVICH and the BOARD have agreed to enter into this CONSENT AGREEMENT which the parties have resolved to be in their mutual best interests.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, MILAN J. PACKOVICH, M.D., and the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO hereby CONSENT and AGREE to the following terms and conditions:

- A. DR. PACKOVICH shall comply with section 3 of the New Jersey Board Order issued him on June 17, 1989 in that he; ".... shall not treat or instruct or counsel others to (a) treat Candida Albicans Overgrowth Syndrome", (b)perform chelation therapy for arterial conditions, or (c) prescribe or administer vitamin and mineral "cocktail" transfusions to patients in this State without notification to the Board, which notification shall include respondent's provision for the Board's review and prior approval, of any and all protocols, treatment modalites and therapies."
- B. DR. PACKOVICH shall submit to THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO any and all doumentation submitted on his behalf to the New Jersey Board as required in Section 3 of the June 17, 1989 Board order.
- C. DR. PACKOVICH shall comply with Section 4 of the New Jersey Board Order issued June 17, 1989.
- D. DR. PACKOVICH shall comply with Section 1 of the West Virginia Board Order issued him on October 19, 1989. In addition, Dr. Packovich shall submit to THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO any and all documentation submitted on his behlf to the West Virginia Board as required in Section 1 of the October 19, 1989 Board Order.
- E. DR. PACKOVICH shall notify THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO if and when he intends to resume the practice of medicine or residency in Ohio.
- F. DR. PACKOVICH shall not engage in any activities referred to in the New Jersey and West Virginia Agreements while in Ohio without prior approval of THE OHIO STATE MEDICAL BOARD.

If in the discretion of the Secretary of THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, MILAN J. PACKOVICH, M.D. appears to have violated or breached any terms or conditions of this agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this agreement.

Upon consent of both parties, the terms and conditions of this agreement may be modified or terminated in writing.

The terms and conditions of this agreement shall become active on the last date of signature below.

DOCTOR PACKOVICH hereby releases THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, its Members, Employees, Agents, Officers and Representatives jointly and severally from any and all liability arising from the within matter.

IT IS AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD by and between the parties that this Consent Agreement shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code.

Further, this information may be reported to appropriate organizations, data banks, and governmental bodies.
