

CONSENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
VICTOR E. BADERTSCHER, M.D.  
AND  
THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO

THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between VICTOR E. BADERTSCHER, M.D. and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapters 4730. and 4731. of the Ohio Revised Code.

VICTOR E. BADERTSCHER, M.D., enters into this agreement being fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel.

This agreement is entered into on the basis of the following statements, admissions and understandings:

- A. VICTOR E. BADERTSCHER, M.D., admits that he has had an addiction to alcohol and drugs.

WHEREAS, in lieu of a formal adjudication hearing, DR. BADERTSCHER and the BOARD have agreed to enter into this CONSENT AGREEMENT which the parties have resolved to be in their mutual best interests.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, VICTOR E. BADERTSCHER, M.D., and the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO hereby CONSENT and AGREE to the following terms and conditions:

- A. DR. BADERTSCHER shall appear before the Secretary of the Board or other representative in three months or as otherwise determined.
- B. DR. BADERTSCHER shall submit to random urine screenings once a week and shall arrange to have the reports of such screenings sent to the Board once a month.
- C. DR. BADERTSCHER shall participate in Alcoholic Anonymous on a regular basis.
- D. DR. BADERTSCHER shall be under the care of a psychiatrist and shall arrange to have such psychiatrist submit reports to the Board once every six months.
- E. DR. BADERTSCHER shall arrange for William R. Thompson, M.D., his employer, to submit monthly progress reports to the Board until otherwise determined.
- F. DR. BADERTSCHER'S license to practice medicine or surgery will be immediately considered for revocation pursuant to Chapter 1347. and 119., Ohio Revised Code, if he should again abuse drugs or alcohol.

If, in the discretion of the Secretary of THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, VICTOR E. BADERTSCHER, M.D. appears to have violated or breached any terms or conditions of this agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this agreement.

Upon consent of both parties, the terms and conditions of this agreement may be modified or terminated in writing.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT supersedes all prior consent agreements between DR. BADERTSCHER and the Board.

The terms and conditions of this agreement shall become effective on the 8th day of February, 1984.

IT IS AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD by and between the parties that this Consent Agreement shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code.

- B. DR. BADERTSCHER shall not prescribe, administer, or dispense Schedule II controlled substances.
- C. DR. BADERTSCHER shall submit to random urine screenings once a week and shall arrange to have the reports of such screenings sent to the Board once a month.
- D. DR. BADERTSCHER shall participate in Alcoholics Anonymous on a regular basis.
- E. DR. BADERTSCHER shall be under the care of a psychiatrist and shall arrange to have such psychiatrist submit reports to the Board once every six months.
- F. DR. BADERTSCHER'S license to practice medicine or surgery will be immediately considered for revocation pursuant to Chapter 1347. and 119., Ohio Revised Code, if he should again abuse drugs or alcohol.



Upon consent of both parties, the terms and conditions of this agreement may be modified or terminated in writing.

The terms and conditions of this agreement shall become effective on the 20th day of December, 1983.
