

**VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF CERTIFICATE
TO PRACTICE MEDICINE AND SURGERY**

I, GEZA LOCSEY, M. D., am aware of my rights to representation by counsel, the right of being formally charged and having a formal adjudicative hearing, and do hereby freely execute this document and choose to take the actions described herein.

I, GEZA LOCSEY, M. D., do hereby voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently surrender all rights to practice medicine under my certificate to practice medicine and surgery, No. 031166, to the Ohio State Medical Board.

I understand that as a result of the surrender herein that I am no longer permitted to practice medicine and surgery in any form or manner in the State of Ohio.

I agree that I shall be ineligible for, and shall not apply for, reinstatement of certificate to practice medicine and surgery No. 031166, or issuance of any other certificate pursuant to Chapters 4730. and 4731., Ohio Revised Code, on or after the date of signing this Voluntary Surrender of Certificate to Practice Medicine and Surgery.

I hereby authorize the State Medical Board of Ohio to enter upon its Journal, an Order revoking my certificate to practice medicine and surgery, No. 031166, in conjunction with which I expressly waive the provision of Section 4731.22(B), Ohio Revised Code, requiring that six (6) Board Members vote to revoke said certificate, and further expressly and forever waive all rights as set forth in Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, including but not limited to my right to counsel, right to a hearing, right to present evidence, right to cross-examine witnesses, and right to appeal the Order of the Board revoking my certificate to practice medicine and surgery.

I stipulate and agree that I am taking the action described herein in lieu of formal disciplinary proceedings pursuant to Section 4731.22(B) (3), and Section 4731.22(B)2, Ohio Revised Code.

This shall become effective immediately.

CONSENT AGREEMENT

BY AND BETWEEN

GEZA LOCSEY, M.D.,

AND


THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO

- I. THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between GEZA LOCSEY, M.D., hereinafter referred to as DR. LOCSEY, party of the first part, and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, hereinafter referred to as BOARD, party of the second.
- II. WHEREAS, DR. LOCSEY is a physician licensed to practice medicine or surgery in the State of Ohio, and is subject to all laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of medicine.
- III. WHEREAS, the BOARD is a state agency charged with enforcing the Medical Practice Act, Revised Code Chapter 4731, which requires that physicians licensed thereunder conform to standards of conduct set forth with particularity therein.
- IV. WHEREAS, on December 12, 1979, the BOARD issued a letter of citation to DR. LOCSEY alleging certain violations of Section 4731.22 of the Revised Code and advising DR. LOCSEY of his right to request a formal adjudication hearing in the matter.
- V. WHEREAS, DR. LOCSEY, through his counsel, did request a formal adjudication hearing, said hearing being scheduled and continued by the BOARD pursuant to Chapter 119. of the Revised Code.
- VI. WHEREAS, in lieu of a formal adjudication hearing, DR. LOCSEY and the BOARD have agreed to enter into this Consent Agreement which the parties have resolved to be in their mutual best interests.
- VII. WHEREAS, DR. LOCSEY denies the allegations contained in the December 12, 1979, letter of citation, but he does accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement. DR. LOCSEY enters into this Consent Agreement voluntarily and after consultation with counsel recognizing that he is waiving his right to a formal adjudication hearing under Chapter 119. of the Revised Code and all other substantive and procedural protections provided by law.
- VIII. WHEREFORE, DR. LOCSEY HEREBY CONSENTS AND AGREES to the following terms and conditions:
 - A. DR. LOCSEY's certificate to practice medicine or surgery in Ohio shall be suspended and he agrees to refrain from the practice of medicine for a period of thirty (30) days, the period of said suspension to run from August 15, 1981, through September 13, 1981.
 - B. Beginning on September 14, 1981, DR. LOCSEY shall be on probation for one (1) year, the conditions of the probation being as follows:
 - 1. DR. LOCSEY shall keep a separate record or log of all Schedule II controlled substances which he prescribes, dispenses or administers, said record containing a patient identifier and the date of and the reason for prescribing, dispensing or administering the substance;
 - 2. The record described in subparagraph B.1. above shall be forwarded to the BOARD quarterly without request, prior to the first day of December, 1981; March, 1982; June, 1982; and September, 1982;

3. DR. LOCSEY shall obey all federal, state and local laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Ohio;
4. DR. LOCSEY shall cooperate fully with the BOARD, its agents, and employees, and, when requested make his place(s) of practice available for inspection.

- IX. IT IS FURTHER AGREED by and between the parties that in the event DR. LOCSEY has violated the terms and conditions of this Agreement, this Consent Agreement shall be construed to be null and void and the BOARD at its discretion may prosecute DR. LOCSEY as if the original complaint which is the subject of this agreement was reinstated Ab Initio.
- X. IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD by and between the parties that this Consent Agreement shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code; however, the BOARD shall not initiate the publication or release of the Agreement but will only make it available for inspection upon request in accordance with Division (B) of that Section.
- XI. UNLESS otherwise agreed to by the prior written approval of both parties, and if it appears that DR. LOCSEY has successfully complied with the terms and conditions set forth herein, this Consent Agreement shall terminate automatically on September 13, 1982.





Dear Doctor Locsey:

In accordance with Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, reprimand, revoke, suspend, place on probation, refuse to register or reinstate your license to practice medicine or surgery in Ohio under the provisions of Section 4731.22, Ohio Revised Code, for the following reasons:

Further, such acts in Paragraph 1 above, individually, and/or collectively, constitute "a departure from, or the failure to conform to, minimal standards of care of similar practitioners under the same or similar circumstances, whether or not actual injury to a patient is established" as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(6), Ohio Revised Code.

In order to best assure protection of any privileges which may exist, the names of the above-mentioned patients are enclosed on a separate form, included in this letter.


You are advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter if you request such hearing within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

In the event there is no request for such hearing made within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, reprimand, revoke, suspend, place on probation, refuse to register, or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine or surgery.

Enclosed is a copy of the Medical Practice Act for your convenience.
