
Please find enclosed a certified copy of the Findings, Order, and Journal Entry approved and confirmed by the State Medical Board meeting in regular session on June 12, 1984.

Section 119.12, Ohio Revised Code, may authorize an appeal from this Order. Such an appeal may be taken to the Court of Common Pleas in the county in which your place of business is located or to said court of the county in which you reside. If you are not a resident of and have no place of business in Ohio, you may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas in Franklin County. Such an appeal setting forth the Order appealed from and the grounds of the appeal must be commenced by the filing of a Notice of Appeal with the State Medical Board of Ohio and the appropriate court within fifteen (15) days after the mailing of this notice and in accordance with the requirements of Section 119.12 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This Order is issued as a matter of statutory formality and applies only to the particular licensure application which was denied. It does not necessarily affect any future applications you may make to Ohio for examination, endorsement, or registration.

Please note the notification of appeal contained herein.



Dear Doctor Yun:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, and under authority of Section 4731.22, Ohio Revised Code, this is to advise you that the State Medical Board of Ohio hereby proposes to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register, refuse to reinstate, reprimand or place on probation your license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio for one or more of the following reasons:

1. On or about June 29, 1983, you were notified by the Georgia Composite State Board of Medical Examiners of formal charges against you which could result in disciplinary action being taken against your license to practice medicine in Georgia. The Notice of Hearing lists eight counts involving your prescribing of controlled substances. A certified copy of said Notice of Hearing is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

On or about July 14, 1983 you entered into a Consent Order with the Georgia Medical Board regarding the charges incorporated above. You did not contest the allegations and waived any further findings of fact. Said Consent Order is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

The fact of and bases for the disciplinary action taken against you in the State of Georgia (see attached Notice of Hearing) are hereby alleged to constitute grounds for this Board to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register, refuse to reinstate, reprimand or place on probation your license to practice medicine and surgery in Ohio under authority of Section 4731.22, Ohio Revised Code, to wit:

1. Section 4731.22(B)(2): Failure to use reasonable care discrimination in the administration of drugs, or failure to employ acceptable scientific methods in the selection of drugs or other modalities for treatment of disease.
2. Section 4731.22(B)(3): Selling, prescribing, giving away, or administering drugs for other than legal and legitimate therapeutic purposes or conviction of violation of any federal or state law regulating the possession, distribution, or use of any drug.

3. Section 4731.22(B)(6): A departure from, or the failure to conform to, minimal standards of care of similiar practitioners under the same or similiar circumstances, whether or not actual injury to a patient is established.


In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you have a right to a hearing in this matter, if you request such hearing within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

In the event there is no request for such hearing made within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board of Ohio may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, reprimand, revoke, suspend, place on probation, refuse to register, or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio.

Copies of the applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code are enclosed for your reference.
