

CONSENT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D.

THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapters 4730. and 4731. of the Ohio Revised Code.

DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., enters into this Agreement being fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel.

This Agreement is being entered into on the basis of the following statements, admissions and understandings:

WHEREAS, DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., admits that he abused Schedule II controlled substances in the past.

WHEREAS, DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., admits that he participated in a designated program at the University of Colorado Health Services Center for drug usage.

WHEREAS, in lieu of a formal adjudication hearing at this time, DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., and the BOARD have agreed to enter into this CONSENT AGREEMENT which the parties have resolved to be in their mutual best interests.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO hereby CONSENT and AGREE to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) THAT DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., agrees to appear before the Board or its agents prior to returning to Ohio for purposes of practicing medicine.
- 2) THAT DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., will continue to submit two (2) random urine screenings per month, per request, at a date and time unknown to him.
- 3) THAT DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., shall be under the care of a monitoring physician acceptable to the Board who shall submit the results of the aforementioned urine screenings when requested to do so by the Board.
- 4) THAT DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., will notify THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD of any change of address or any change of employment or in employment status.

If, in the discretion of the Secretary of THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, DAVID P. SCHULTZ, M.D., appears to have violated or breached any terms or conditions of this Agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this Agreement.

Upon consent of both parties, the terms and conditions of this Agreement, may be modified or terminated in writing. 84-50-12 p1:20

IT IS AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD by and between the parties that this CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code.
