CONSENT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

ALLEN OKIE, M.D.

AND

THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO

THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between ALLEN OKIE, M.D. and THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Chapters 4730. and 4731. of the Ohio Revised Code.

ALLEN OKIE, M.D., enters into this agreement being fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel.

WHEREAS, in consideration of the BOARD'S motion of February 8, 1984 to issue DR. OKIE a license with limitations, DR. OKIE and the BOARD have agreed to enter into this CONSENT AGREEMENT which the parties have resolved to be in their mutual best interests.

WHEREFORE, ALLEN OKIE, M.D., and the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO hereby CONSENT and AGREE to the following terms and conditions:


- A. DR. OKIE shall not establish or participate in an allergy consultation practice in Ohio, wherein he diagnoses or treats medical conditions without personally examining the patients.

If, in the discretion of the Secretary of THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, ALLEN OKIE, M.D. appears to have violated or breached any terms or conditions of this agreement, THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches, including, but not limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this agreement.


Upon consent of both parties, the terms and conditions of this agreement may be modified or terminated in writing.

The terms and conditions of this agreement shall become effective on the 22 day of July, 1985



Dear Doctor Okie:

I regret to inform you that the State Medical Board, at its February 20, 1985 meeting, reconsidered your request for endorsement licensure and proposed to deny said request.

This decision was based upon the understanding that you desire to be licensed in Ohio, yet not be present to perform examinations and obtain histories from the patients involved, in violation of minimal standards of care (see Section 4731.22(B)(6), Revised Code, as enclosed).

Please be advised that, pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are entitled to a hearing on this matter. If you wish to request such a hearing, that request must be made within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice. Final action may be taken on the proposed denial if a timely request for hearing is not made.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such a hearing in person, or by your attorney, or you may present your positions, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.
