

Dear Doctor Sharma:

I regret to inform you that the State Medical Board, at its November 6, 1986 meeting proposed to deny your request for Ohio licensure for one or more of the following reasons:

1. Your December 1982 FLEX scores cannot be constructively accepted as if taken in (transferred to) Ohio because you had not completed 24 months of postdoctoral training in an approved hospital in the United States, or its equivalent, at that time as required of graduates of foreign medical schools under Section 4731.09, Revised Code and Rule 4731-3-16, Ohio Administrative Code.
2. Your Illinois license cannot be endorsed to Ohio since it is based upon endorsement of your California FLEX exam. (See Rule 4731-3-18(C)), Ohio Administrative Code)

I would suggest that you pursue your California license and then apply for endorsement of that license to Ohio.


In accordance with Chapter 119., Revised Code, please be advised that you may request a hearing on this matter. If you wish to request such a hearing, that request must be made within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice. Final action may be taken on the proposed denial if a timely request for hearing is not made.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

Copies of Section 4731.09, Revised Code and Rules 4731-3-16 and 4731-3-18, Ohio Administrative Code, are enclosed for your information and review.
