

**CONSENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
PREM K. VARMA, M.D.,  
AND  
THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between PREM K. VARMA, M.D., and the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, a state agency charged with enforcing Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4731.

PREM K. VARMA, M.D., enters into this AGREEMENT being fully informed of his rights under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudicative hearing on the issues considered herein.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

- A. The STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO is empowered by Ohio Revised Code Section 4731.22(B) to limit, revoke, suspend a certificate, refuse to register or reinstate an applicant, or reprimand or place on probation the holder of a certificate for violation of any of the enumerated subsections.
- B. The STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT based upon the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing dated February 12, 1992, a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein, and expressly reserves the right to institute formal proceedings based upon any other violations of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4731, whether occurring before or after the effective date of this AGREEMENT.

C. PREM K. VARMA, M.D., admits the factual allegations contained within the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing dated February 12, 1992, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, PREM K. VARMA, M.D., knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO to the following terms:

1. The charges against PREM K. VARMA, M.D., are hereby dismissed with no penalty.
2. PREM K. VARMA, M.D., agrees to release the STATE MEDICAL BOARD, its members, employees, agents, officers and representatives, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from actions taken to date regarding the within matter, including liability for attorney fees.

The above described terms, limitations and conditions may be amended or terminated in writing at any time upon the agreement of both parties.

If, in the discretion of the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, PREM K. VARMA, M.D., appears to have violated or breached any term or condition of this AGREEMENT, the STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings for any and all possible violations or breaches.

PREM K. VARMA, M.D., acknowledges that he has had an opportunity to ask questions concerning the terms of this AGREEMENT and that all questions asked have been answered in a satisfactory manner.

Dear Doctor Varma:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery, or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons.

Further, in accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to deny your application for a temporary certificate to practice medicine and surgery, for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) a. On or about April 4, 1991, you submitted an application for a certificate to practice medicine and surgery to the State Medical Board of Ohio.
- b. On or about August 15, 1991, an application for a temporary certificate to practice medicine and surgery was filed on your behalf with the State Medical Board of Ohio.
- (2) On or about February 27, 1990 you were found guilty in the Cleveland Municipal Court of the charge of \_\_\_\_\_ a misdemeanor of the first degree, in violation of M.C. \_\_\_\_\_, a charge to which you pleaded "No Contest".

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (2) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "a plea of guilty to, or a judicial finding of guilt of, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(13), Ohio Revised Code.

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Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (2) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute a failure to furnish satisfactory proof of good moral character as required by Sections 4731.08 and 4731.291(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.


You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before this agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

In the event that there is no request for such hearing received within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice medicine and surgery or to reprimand or place you on probation.

Further, in the event that is no request for such hearing received within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to deny your application for a temporary certificate to practice medicine and surgery.
