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
FINDINGS, ORDER, AND JOURNAL ENTRY

Notice was given to the above individual that the State Medical Board of Ohio had proposed to deny licensure or certification and that he or she was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice. The above individual has not requested a hearing, and thirty (30) days have elapsed since the mailing of the aforesaid notice.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that for the reasons outlined in the letter of notice which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, accordingly, licensure or certification of the above individual is denied.

Dear Doctor Turkmani:

Please be advised that the State Medical Board of Ohio proposes to deny your application for the June, 1984 FLEX examination for one or more of the following reasons:

1. On your application for licensure, received March 23, 1984, you indicated you quit your residency at Pontiac General Hospital, Pontiac, Michigan, after August, 1983 due to the catastrophic death of three members of your family in Lebanon, and that you could not return to the U.S. until four months later because the airport and seaport were closed.

Upon request for clarification, you indicated in a resume received on April 27, 1984, and in a letter received May 22, 1984, that you were actually working at the Conner Medical Clinic in Detroit, Michigan, and not in Lebanon.

2. On your application for licensure, received March 23, 1984, you responded to Question 1(b), Section 4, "List all FLEX exams which you have taken. Indicate whether you took all three days (place an "X" next to full) or whether you took only part of the exam (place an "X" next to Partial)" that you had taken the FLEX one time in December, 1983 and FAILED.

Contact with the Michigan licensing authority reveals that you have taken the FLEX four times and failed each time.

Pursuant to Section 4731.22(A), the state medical board may revoke or refuse to grant a certificate to a person found by the board to have committed fraud in passing the examination, or to have committed fraud, misrepresentation, or deception in applying for or securing any license or certificate issued by the board.

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
Further, your acts or omissions in paragraphs 1 and 2 above show a failure of "good moral character", satisfactory proof of which is required pursuant to Section 4751.08, Revised Code.

In accordance with Chapter 119., this letter is to advise you that you are entitled to request a hearing on this matter. If you wish to request such a hearing, that request must be made within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice. Final action may be taken on the proposed denial if a timely request for hearing is not made.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

A copy of Ohio's Medical Practice Act is enclosed for your information and review.
