FINDINGS, ORDER AND JOURNAL ENTRY

This matter came on for consideration after a citation letter was mailed to Kenneth Parker, DPM by the State Medical Board of Ohio on February 8, 1995, and then hand delivered on, or about February 21, 1995.

By letter dated February 8, 1995, notice was given to Doctor Parker that the State Medical Board intended to consider disciplinary action regarding his license to practice podiatric medicine and surgery in Ohio, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the delivery date of said notice. In accordance with Section 119.09, Ohio Revised Code, said notice was hand delivered to Dr. Parker by Medical Board Investigator Brenda Harrison.

No hearing request has been received from Doctor Parker and more than thirty (30) days have now elapsed since the delivery of the aforesaid notice.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons outlined in the February 8, 1995 letter of notice, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Kenneth Parker, DPM to practice podiatric medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio be PERMANENTLY
REVOKED.

This Order shall become effective JUNE 14, 1995.



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NOTICE OF IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION

AND

OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

Dear Doctor Parker:

In accordance with Sections 2929.17 and/or 3719.12(B), Ohio Revised Code, the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney of Summit County, Ohio reported that on or about January 19, 1995, in the Summit County Court of Common Pleas, you were found guilty of one (1) felony count of Aggravated Trafficking and one (1) felony count of Trafficking in Drugs in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 3719.121(C), Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that your license to practice podiatry in the State of Ohio is immediately suspended. Continued practice after this suspension shall be considered practicing podiatry without a certificate in violation of Section 4731.60, Ohio Revised Code.

Furthermore, in accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice podiatry, or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) On or about January 19, 1995, in the Summit County Court of Common Pleas, you were found guilty of one (1) felony count of Aggravated Trafficking and one (1) felony count of Trafficking in Drugs in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "(s)elling, prescribing, giving away, or administering drugs

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for other than legal and legitimate therapeutic purposes or a plea of guilty to, or a judicial finding of guilt of, a violation of any federal or state law regulating the possession, distribution, or use of any drug." as those clauses are used in Section 4731.22(B)(3), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "(a) plea of guilty to, or a judicial finding of guilt of, a felony," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code.


Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before this agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

In the event that there is no request for such hearing received within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice podiatry or to reprimand or place you on probation.
