In consideration of the foregoing and of Dr. Thompson's express waiver of the provision of Section 4731.22(B), Ohio Revised Code, requiring that six (6) Board members vote to revoke said certificate, it is hereby ORDERED that Certificate No. 36-002543 authorizing Edwin G. Thompson, D.P.M., to practice podiatric medicine be permanently REVOKED, effective October 25, 2001.

**SURRENDER OF CERTIFICATE TO PRACTICE
PODIATRIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY**

I, EDWIN G. THOMPSON, D.P.M., am aware of my rights to representation by counsel, the right of being formally charged and having a formal adjudicative hearing, and do hereby freely execute this document and choose to take the actions described herein.

I, EDWIN G. THOMPSON, D.P.M., do hereby voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently surrender my Certificate to Practice Podiatric Medicine and Surgery, No. 36-002543, to the State Medical Board of Ohio, thereby relinquishing all rights to practice podiatric medicine and surgery in Ohio.

I understand that as a result of the surrender herein that I am no longer permitted to practice podiatric medicine and surgery in any form or manner in the State of Ohio. This Surrender of Certificate to Practice Podiatric Medicine and Surgery shall be effective upon the last date of signature below.

I agree that I shall be ineligible for, and shall not apply for, reinstatement of certificate to practice podiatric medicine and surgery No. 36-002543, or issuance of any other certificate pursuant to Chapters 4730., 4731., 4760. or 4762., Ohio Revised Code, on or after the date of signing this Surrender of Certificate to Practice Podiatric Medicine and Surgery. Any such attempted reapplication shall be considered null and void and shall not be processed by the Board.

I hereby authorize the State Medical Board of Ohio to enter upon its Journal an Order permanently revoking my certificate to practice podiatric medicine and surgery, No. 36-002543, in conjunction with which I expressly waive the provision of Section 4731.22(B), Ohio Revised Code, requiring that six (6) Board Members vote to revoke said certificate, and further expressly and forever waive all rights as set forth in Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, including but not limited to my right to counsel, right to a hearing, right to present evidence, right to cross-examine witnesses, and right to appeal the Order of the Board revoking my certificate to practice podiatric medicine and surgery.

I, EDWIN G. THOMPSON, D.P.M., hereby release the State Medical Board of Ohio, its members, employees, agents and officers, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the within matter.

This document shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43, Ohio Revised Code.

Further, this information may be reported to appropriate organizations, data banks and governmental bodies. Dr. Thompson agrees to provide his social security number to the Board and hereby authorizes the Board to utilize that number in conjunction with that reporting
