
Dear Mr. Farren:



FINDINGS, ORDER, AND JOURNAL ENTRY

This matter came on for consideration after a citation letter was issued to Robert A. Farren, D.M., by the State Medical Board of Ohio on September 12, 1990.

On September 12, 1990, notice was given to Dr. Farren that the State Medical Board proposed to deny his request for restoration of his mechanotherapy certificate, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice. In accordance with Section 119.09, Ohio Revised Code, said notice was sent via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of Robert A. Farren, D.M., that being 17919 Detroit Ave., Lakewood, OH 44107.

No request for hearing has been received and thirty (30) days have elapsed since the mailing of the aforesaid notice.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that for the reasons outlined in the September 12, 1990 letter of notice, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, accordingly, Dr. Farren's request for restoration of his mechano-therapy certificate be DENIED.

This ORDER shall become effective IMMEDIATELY.

Dear Mr. Farren:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice mechanotherapy, or to reprimand or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) On or about August 17, 1990, upon submitting your application for the restoration of your mechanotherapy certificate, you answered "No" to the question: "Has any license entitling you to practice in any state or territory of the United States or in any foreign country been suspended, surrendered, or revoked?" In fact, on or about March 22, 1990 the Ohio Board of Chiropractic Examiners issued an Order revoking your chiropractic license, a copy of which is attached and fully incorporated herein.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "fraud, misrepresentation, or deception in applying for or securing any license or certificate issued by the board," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(A), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraph (1) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "publishing a false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statement," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(5), Ohio Revised Code.

- (2) On or about April 18, 1987 you did, without medical justification, intentionally fondle the clitoris of Patient 1, as identified in the attached Patient Key.

- (3) On or about March 19, 1987 you did, without medical justification, cup the breasts of Patient 3, as identified in the attached Patient Key, run your hands over the pubic area, and run your fingers through the pubic hair of Patient 2.
- (4) In or about the summer of 1983 through July 1988 you did, without medical justification, brush your hands and arms across the breasts and pubic area of Patient 4, as identified in the attached Patient Key. Further, on or about July 22, 1988 you did, without medical justification, run both hands down the sides of the breasts of Patient 3 and kiss her on the lips.

Your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraphs (2), (3) and (4) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "commission of an act that constitutes a misdemeanor in this state regardless of the jurisdiction in which the act was committed, if the act was committed in the course of practice," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(12), Ohio Revised Code, to wit: Section 2907.06(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code, "Sexual Imposition," a misdemeanor of the third degree.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions as alleged in paragraphs (2), (3) and (4) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "commission of an act that constitutes a misdemeanor in this state regardless of the jurisdiction in which the act was committed, if the act involves moral turpitude," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(14), Ohio Revised Code, to wit: Section 2907.06(A)(1), Ohio Revised Code, "Sexual Imposition," a misdemeanor of the third degree.

Further, your acts, conduct, and/or omissions, individually and/or collectively, demonstrate that you lack the good moral character required by Section 4731.08, Ohio Revised Code, for a certificate to be issued.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before this agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

September 12, 1990

In the event that there is no request for such hearing received within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your certificate to practice mechanotherapy or to reprimand or place you on probation.
