
Dear Dr. Edmiston:



FINDINGS, ORDER AND JOURNAL ENTRY

By letter dated May 13, 2009, notice was given to Logan John Edmiston, M.D., that the State Medical Board intended to consider disciplinary action regarding his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice. In accordance with Section 119.07, Ohio Revised Code, said notice was sent via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the address of record of Dr. Edmiston, that being Summa Health System, c/o Medical Education Dept., 525 East Market Street, Akron, Ohio 44304. A duplicate copy of the notice was also sent to 2043 Randon Road, #309, Cleveland, Ohio 44106.

A signed certified mail receipt was returned to the Medical Board offices documenting proper service of the notice. Through counsel, Dr. Edmiston submitted a written request for hearing; however, such hearing request was subsequently withdrawn on February 24, 2010.

WHEREFORE, having reviewed the May 13, 2009, Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, a certified copy of the Journal Entry of the Court of Common Pleas for Cuyahoga County, Ohio, in the State of Ohio v. Logan John Edmiston, Case Number CR-09-521013-A, the affidavit of David P. Katko, Enforcement Attorney, as well as the affidavit of Kay L. Rieve, Administrative Officer, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein, the Board hereby finds that:

On or about March 31, 2009, in the Court of Common Pleas for Cuyahoga County, Ohio, Logan John Edmiston, M.D. was found guilty of one felony count of Pandering Obscenity in violation of Section 2907.32(A)(4), Ohio Revised Code, and two misdemeanor counts of Public Indecency in violation of Section 2907.09(A)(3), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, the Board hereby concludes that:


1. Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code, authorizes the State Medical Board of Ohio to refuse to issue a license or to discipline a licensee based upon a plea of guilty to, a judicial finding of guilt of, or a judicial finding of eligibility for intervention in lieu of conviction for, a felony.
2. Dr. Edmiston has been convicted of Pandering Obscenity, a felony, as described above.
3. Section 4731.22(B)(13), Ohio Revised Code, authorizes the State Medical Board of Ohio to refuse to issue a license or to discipline a licensee based upon a plea of guilty to, a judicial finding of guilt of, or a judicial finding of eligibility for intervention in lieu of conviction for, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
4. Dr. Edmiston has been convicted on two counts of Public Indecency, misdemeanors involving moral turpitude, as described above.

Accordingly, the Board hereby ORDERS that:

The license of Logan John Edmiston, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Ohio be PERMANENTLY REVOKED.

This Order shall become effective IMMEDIATELY.

This Order is hereby entered upon the Journal of the State Medical Board of Ohio for the 14th day of April 2010 and the original thereof shall be kept with said Journal.

Dear Doctor Edmiston:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board of Ohio [Board] intends to determine whether or not to limit, revoke, permanently revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your training certificate, or to reprimand you or place you on probation for one or more of the following reasons:

- (1) On or about May 12, 2008, you caused to be submitted an Application for Training Certificate to the Board. You were granted a Training Certificate for the period of July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2009.
- (2) On or about March 31, 2009, in the Court of Common Pleas for Cuyahoga County, Ohio, you were found guilty of one felony count of Pandering Obscenity in violation of Section 2907.32(A)(4), Ohio Revised Code, and two misdemeanor counts of Public Indecency in violation of Section 2907.09(A)(3), Ohio Revised Code. The conduct underlying your convictions involved you exposing yourself and masturbating in front of a female in a closed elevator.

Your plea of guilty or the judicial finding of guilt as alleged in paragraph (2) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "[a] plea of guilty to, a judicial finding of guilt of, or a judicial finding of eligibility for intervention in lieu of conviction for, a felony," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(9), Ohio Revised Code.

Further, your plea of guilty or the judicial finding of guilt as alleged in paragraph (2) above, individually and/or collectively, constitute "[a] plea of guilty to, a judicial finding of guilt of, or a judicial finding of eligibility for intervention in lieu of conviction for, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude," as that clause is used in Section 4731.22(B)(13), Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby advised that you are entitled to a hearing in this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, the request must

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be made in writing and must be received in the offices of the State Medical Board within thirty days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that, if you timely request a hearing, you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or by such other representative as is permitted to practice before this agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

In the event that there is no request for such hearing received within thirty days of the time of mailing of this notice, the State Medical Board may, in your absence and upon consideration of this matter, determine whether or not to limit, revoke, permanently revoke, suspend, refuse to register or reinstate your training certificate or to reprimand you or place you on probation.

Please note that, whether or not you request a hearing, Section 4731.22(L), Ohio Revised Code, provides that "[w]hen the board refuses to grant a certificate to an applicant, revokes an individual's certificate to practice, refuses to register an applicant, or refuses to reinstate an individual's certificate to practice, the board may specify that its action is permanent. An individual subject to a permanent action taken by the board is forever thereafter ineligible to hold a certificate to practice and the board shall not accept an application for reinstatement of the certificate or for issuance of a new certificate."
