




FINDINGS, ORDER, AND JOURNAL ENTRY

On November 6, 1986, notice was given to Dr. Ippolito Colla that the State Medical Board proposed to deny his application for licensure in Ohio, and that he was entitled to a hearing if such hearing was requested within thirty (30) days of the mailing of said notice. On November 23, 1986, Dr. Colla requested a hearing, but withdrew that request by letter dated February 19, 1987.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that for the reasons outlined in the letter of proposed denial of licensure, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, accordingly, the application of Ippolito Colla, M.D., to practice in Ohio be DENIED.

This ORDER is hereby entered upon the Journal of the State Medical Board of Ohio for the 12th day of March, 1987, and the original thereof shall be kept with said Journal.

Dear Doctor Colla:

In accordance with Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, you are hereby notified that the State Medical Board proposes to deny your application for licensure for the following reasons:

1. On or about February 18, 1986, you filed an application to sit for the FLEX examination for purposes of Ohio licensure.

In response to Question 1(b) of Section 4 of the application you indicated that you had taken the FLEX examination in the following states on the following dates:

<u>State</u>	<u>Date</u>
Illinois	June 1982
Illinois	December 1982
Illinois	June 1984
Illinois	June 1985

Question 1(b) of Section 4 states: "List all FLEX exams which you have taken. Indicate whether you took all three days or whether you took only part of the exam." Lines are provided for the State of examination, date, whether full or partial examination, and whether passed or failed.

In fact, the board has now been advised by the Federation of State Medical Boards that prior to February 1986 you sat for the FLEX examination in Washington, D.C. on the following dates: December 1975 and June 1976. You sat for the FLEX exam in Indiana in June 1977, December 1977, June 1978. You sat for the FLEX examination in Illinois in June 1982, December 1982, June 1983, and June 1985.

2. You have not completed 24 months of postdoctoral training in an approved hospital in the United States, or its equivalent. (See Section 4731.09, Revised Code, and Rule 4731-3-16(A), Ohio Administrative Code)
3. You do not hold ECFMG certification as required under Rule 4731-3-16(B), Ohio Administrative Code.

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Your acts, conduct and omissions as alleged in paragraph 1 constitute a violation of Section 4731.22(A), Ohio Revised Code, to wit: committing fraud, misrepresentation, or deception in applying for or securing any license or certificate issued by the Board.

Further, your acts, conduct and omissions as listed in paragraph 1 establish a failure to furnish satisfactory proof of good moral character as required by Section 4731.08, Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Chapter 119., Ohio Revised Code, please be advised that you may request a hearing on this matter. If you wish to request such hearing, that request must be made within thirty (30) days of the time of mailing of this notice.

You are further advised that you are entitled to appear at such hearing in person, or by your attorney, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing, and that at the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing for or against you.

A copy of the applicable sections are enclosed for your information.
