

Anesthesiologist Assistants

FAQ's

Q: May I practice as an Anesthesiologist Assistant while I am waiting for my NCCAA certification?

No. The Board must received an application, certification from NCCAA, and approve registration before you begin practicing as an Anesthesiologist Assistant.

Q: How long does the licensure process take?

The usual time is 60 days (2 months). All applicants must be approved at a monthly Board meeting and all documentation completed before a registration can be issued.

Q: Do I need a recommendation letter from my program if I am a new graduate?

Yes. New graduates can submit a letter from a physician who worked with them in their Anesthesiologist Assistant program, and Anesthesiologist Assistants who are currently employed may submit a letter from their employer.
