

**STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO
FORMAL ACTION REPORT – JULY 2008**

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Listed below is a summary of the disciplinary actions taken or initiated by the State Medical Board of Ohio in July 2008 and an update of Board matters pending in courts as of the date of this document.

PRE-HEARING SUSPENSION

MILLER, Robert Wayne (LMT #33-016769) - Norwalk, OH

Pursuant to Section 4731.22(I), O.R.C., massage therapy license automatically suspended based on massage therapist's having been found guilty in the Huron County Court of Common Pleas of one count of Gross Sexual Imposition, a felony of the third degree. Suspension effective 5/28/08; Notice mailed 7/10/08. (See also: Citations/Proposed Denials below)

NARAMORE, Lloyd Stanley (DO #34-002518) – Cincinnati, OH

Pursuant to determination by the Mahoning County Child Support Enforcement Agency that doctor is in default under a child support order, medical license immediately suspended until such time as Board receives notice from that agency that doctor is no longer determined to be in default. Notice mailed 7/11/08; suspension effective 7/11/08.

SUMMERS, Robert Rowan (DO #34-006606) – Defiance, OH

Pursuant to Section 4731.22(G), O.R.C., medical license summarily suspended based on the Board's determination that there is clear and convincing evidence that (1) doctor has violated the terms of limitations placed on doctor's medical license, (2) doctor's ability to practice is impaired due to use and/or abuse of drugs or other substances; and (3) doctor's continued practice presents a danger of immediate and serious harm to the public. Suspension effective 7/9/08; Notice mailed 7/10/08. (See also: Citations/Proposed Denials below)

TAYLOR, Thomas Edward (PA #50-001707) – Westerville, OH

Pursuant to Section 4730.25(G), O.R.C., physician assistant license summarily suspended based on the Board's determination that physician assistant is impaired due to use and/or abuse of drugs or other substances and physician assistant's continued practice presents a danger of immediate and serious harm to the public. Suspension effective 7/9/08; Notice mailed 7/10/08. (See also: Citations/Proposed Denials below)

CITATIONS & PROPOSED DENIALS

ANTHONY, James J. (MD #35-032632) – Cincinnati, OH

Based on doctor's alleged failure to conform to minimal standards of care with respect to treatment of one specified patient. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08.

BREWER-EDWARDS, Celeste Daneen (PA #50-001976) – Cleveland, OH

Based on physician assistant's alleged violation of conditions of limitation placed on physician assistant license by 11/15/07 consent agreement due to failure to submit required reports of random urines screens for drugs and alcohol. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08.

DEAN, Lynda Lee (LMT #33-007728) – Cape Coral, FL

Proposal to deny application for restoration of massage therapy license based on massage therapist having twice been found guilty in Hamilton County Court of Common Pleas of felonious possession of cocaine and failing to report on the original massage therapy license application having been found guilty in the Hamilton County Municipal Court of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Drugs of Abuse. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08.

DEAN, Lynda Lee (LMT #33-007728) – Cape Coral, FL

Massage therapist notified of right to request a hearing on the question of whether massage therapist's failure to submit to a mental or physical examination as ordered by the Board was due to circumstances beyond the massage therapist's control. Based on the legal presumption that massage therapist's failure to submit to a mental or physical examination as ordered by the Board constitutes admission of the legal and factual allegations demonstrating that massage therapist is impaired in the ability to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care because of habitual or excessive use or abuse of drugs, alcohol, or other substances that impair ability to practice. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08.

HOOGENDOORN, Kyle Elliott (DPM #36-003064) – Grove City, OH

Based on doctor's alleged failure to conform to minimal standards of care with respect to treatment of eight specified patients. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08.

McCOMB, Jason D. (MT Applicant) – Gahanna, OH

Based on applicant having been found, pursuant to a Board-ordered evaluation, to be impaired in the ability to practice massage therapy according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care because of habitual or excessive use or abuse of drugs, alcohol, or other substances. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08.

MILLER, Robert Wayne (LMT #33-016769) – Norwalk, OH

Based on massage therapist having been found guilty in the Huron County Court of Common Pleas of Gross Sexual Imposition, a felony of the third degree. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08. (See also: Pre-hearing Suspension)

NAPOLI, William Michael (DO #34-005791) – New Philadelphia, OH

Based on doctor's alleged failure to conform to minimal standards of care with respect to treatment of 20 specified patients; alleged failure to maintain minimal standards or employ acceptable scientific methods in the selection of drugs or other treatment modalities; and alleged selling, giving away, personally furnishing, prescribing, or administering drugs for other than legal and legitimate therapeutic purposes. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08.

SUMMERS, Robert Rowan (DO #34-006606) – Defiance, OH

Based on doctor's alleged violation of conditions of limitation placed on medical license by Board's 1/4/08 Order due to alleged relapse on alcohol; alleged impairment of ability to practice

according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care because of habitual or excessive use or abuse of alcohol or other substances; and alleged false or fraudulent statements on documents submitted to the Board. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08. (See also: Pre-hearing Suspension)

TAYLOR, Thomas Edward (PA #50-001707) – Westerville, OH

Based on physician assistant's having been found, pursuant to a Board-ordered evaluation, to be impaired in the ability to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care because of habitual or excessive use or abuse of drugs, alcohol, or other substances, for which physician assistant has not completed treatment at a Board-approved treatment provider. Notice of opportunity for hearing mailed 7/10/08. (See also: Pre-hearing Suspension)

DISMISSAL OF CITATION

JOHNSON, Cynthia Joan (PA #50-001350) – Cleveland, OH

Order and Entry issued by the Board on 7/9/08 (1) vacated the 12/12/07 Board Order and (2) dismissed the allegations set forth in the 4/12/07 notice of opportunity for hearing. Order and Entry issued in compliance with the 6/13/08 Decision of the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas; Order and Entry effective 7/9/08. (See also: Final Disciplinary Orders; Probation Completed)

FINAL DISCIPLINARY ORDERS

ADKINS, Paula Clark (MD #35-072775) – Pinehurst, NC

Revocation of medical license stayed subject to suspension for at least 180 days; interim monitoring conditions, conditions for reinstatement, and subsequent probationary terms, conditions, and limitations for at least five years established; Order supersedes the 3/14/07 Board Order. Based on doctor's relapse on drugs and prior actions by North Carolina and West Virginia medical boards. Order effective 7/11/08.

JOHNSON, Carolyn Elizabeth (MD #35-069726) – Detroit, MI

Medical license revoked. Based on doctor's failure to cooperate in a Board investigation. Order effective 7/11/08.

JOHNSON, Cynthia Joan (PA #50-001350) – Cleveland, OH

Order and Entry issued by the Board on 7/9/08 (1) vacated the 12/12/07 Board Order and (2) dismissed the allegations set forth in the 4/12/07 notice of opportunity for hearing. Order and Entry issued in compliance with the 6/13/08 Decision of the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas; Order and Entry effective 7/9/08. (See also: Dismissal of Citation; Probation Completed)

NEKROSIUS, W. Scott (MD #35-042576) – Dayton, OH

Medical license restored, doctor's practice limited to participation in a post-graduate training program approved in advance by the Board; conditions for termination of limitation established; subsequent probationary terms, conditions, and limitations established for at least three years. Order issued pursuant to doctor's March 2002 consent agreement with the Board for the purpose of determining the terms, conditions, and limitations, if any, that should be imposed upon the doctor based upon the recommendations of the Colorado Physicians Effectiveness Program. Order effective 8/5/08.

WOLF, Bradley Rex (MD #35-052721) – Cincinnati, OH

Permanent revocation of medical license stayed subject to suspension for at least 90 days, conditions for reinstatement, and subsequent probationary terms, conditions, and limitations for at least one year established. Based on doctor's complicity in aiding and abetting the unlicensed practice of an individual in providing clinical services. Order effective 8/5/08.

DREWS, Kenneth Lester (MD Applicant) – Monroe, MI

Application for medical license permanently denied based on applicant's having made false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statements in attempting to secure an Ohio medical license, prior action by North Dakota's medical board, applicant's failure to submit satisfactory evidence of good moral character, and applicant's incomplete application. Order effective 7/10/08. (Review and Journal Entry - no hearing requested)

BOROVICH, Kathryn Amy (LMT #33-015153) – Milford, OH

Massage therapy license suspended indefinitely; conditions for reinstatement established; subsequent probationary terms, conditions, and limitations established for at least five years. Based on legal presumption that massage therapist is impaired in the ability to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care because of habitual or excessive use or abuse of drugs, alcohol, or other substances. Order effective 7/9/08. (Journal Entry – no hearing requested)

DEW, Gregory Scott (PA #50-002255) – Columbiana, OH

Physician assistant license permanently revoked. Based on physician assistant having been convicted of rape and gross sexual imposition. Order effective 7/9/08. (Journal Entry – no hearing requested)

GREENE, David Lawrence (MD Applicant) – Phoenix, AZ

Application for medical license denied. Based on prior actions by the Arizona board. Order effective 7/9/08. (Journal Entry – no hearing requested)

CONSENT AGREEMENTS

FRANKOWSKI, Deborah Lynne (MD #35-071191) – Loveland, OH

Medical license suspended for at least 15 months from June 13, 2007; interim monitoring conditions and conditions for reinstatement established, including requirement that doctor enter into subsequent consent agreement incorporating probationary terms, conditions, and limitations to monitor practice. Based on doctor's admission of having been found eligible by the Hamilton County Court of Common Pleas for treatment in lieu of conviction following doctor's guilty plea to one felony count of Deception to Obtain a Dangerous Drug; the underlying basis being doctor's admitted obtaining of hydrocodone for self-use by several methods, including from prescriptions in the name of employees and family members and from medications returned by patients. Agreement effective 7/9/08.

HENDERSON, Malcolm Warren (MD Training Certificate #57-010175) – Youngstown, OH

Medical license suspended for at least 180 days; interim monitoring conditions and conditions for reinstatement established, including requirement that doctor enter into subsequent consent agreement incorporating probationary terms, conditions, and limitations to monitor practice.

Based on doctor's admitted history of use of Fentanyl, which doctor obtained from hospital stock, and admission of currently being impaired in ability to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care due to habitual and excessive use or abuse of a substance that impairs ability to practice. Agreement effective 7/9/08.

JOHNSON, James Cameron (DO #34-007672) – Grove City, OH

Consent agreement of 12/12/07 terminated; medical license suspended until at least 9/7/08; interim monitoring conditions and conditions for reinstatement established, including requirement that doctor enter into subsequent consent agreement incorporating probationary terms, conditions, and limitations to monitor practice. Based on doctor's admitted relapse on alcohol. Agreement effective 7/9/08.

LEVE, Brian Edward (MD #35-082937) – Lancaster, OH

Medical license reinstated subject to probationary terms, conditions, and limitations imposed to monitor practice based on doctor having been deemed capable of practicing according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care so long as certain treatment and monitoring conditions are in place. Agreement effective 7/9/08; agreement to remain in effect for at least five years prior to any request for termination.

VJECHA, Michael Joseph (MD #35-049553) – Washington, DC

Medical license reinstated subject to probationary terms, conditions, and limitations imposed to monitor practice based on doctor having been deemed capable of practicing according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care so long as certain treatment and monitoring conditions are in place. Agreement effective 7/9/08; agreement to remain in effect for at least five years prior to any request for termination.

ZIMMERMAN, Kimberly Rose (MD #35-054521) – Shadow Hills, CA

Probationary terms, conditions, and limitations established, including requirement that doctor receive written approval from the Board prior to practice in Ohio. Based on doctor's admission of prior action by the California medical board against doctor's license in that state, the underlying basis being doctor's care involving one specified patient. Agreement effective 7/9/08; agreement to remain in effect for at least three years prior to any request for termination.

APPLICATION WITHDRAWN

FAUTEUX, Mary B. (PA Applicant) – Cambridge, OH

Request for permanent withdrawal of application for physician assistant licensure accepted by Board in lieu of formal disciplinary proceedings based on applicant's failure to disclose on the Ohio licensure application all information pertaining to the West Virginia medical board's prior action against physician assistant's license in that state. Effective 7/9/08.

MASOOLTONDKAR, Farzaneh (MD Applicant / MD Training Certificate #57-007807) – Toledo, OH (a.k.a. TONDKAR, FARZANEH MASOOL)

Request for permanent withdrawal of application for medical licensure accepted by Board in lieu of further investigation of allegations that doctor made false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statements. Effective 7/9/08.

VOLUNTARY SURRENDER

GALUPO, Pedrito Apoong (MD #35-033085) – Bryan, OH

Board Order permanently revoking doctor's medical license as authorized by doctor in lieu of further investigation related to doctor's alleged selling, giving away, personally furnishing, prescribing, or administering drugs for other than legal and legitimate therapeutic purposes, or the violation of a federal or state law regulating the possession, distribution, or use of any drug. Effective 7/9/08.

STIEBY, Mark Allen (DPM #36-003054) – Cincinnati, OH

Board Order permanently revoking doctor's podiatric medical license as authorized by doctor in lieu of further investigation related to doctor's pending guilty plea to a felony charge of conspiring to distribute oxycodone. Effective 7/9/08.

PROBATION COMPLETED

JOHNSON, Cynthia Joan (PA #50-001350) – Cleveland, OH

By consent agreement with the Board, physician assistant released from terms of 1/8/03 consent agreement. Release from probation effective 7/9/08. (See also: Dismissal of Citation; Final Disciplinary Orders)

RANGA, Puttagunta (MD #35-045040) – New Bremen, OH

Doctor's request for release from the terms of the 7/12/06 consent agreement granted by 7/9/08 Board vote. Release from probation effective 7/12/08.

SAVA, Guy M. (MD #35-039131) – Somerset, KY

Doctor's request for release from the terms of the 4/2/03 Board Order granted by 7/9/08 Board vote. Release from probation effective 7/9/08.

WILSON, Paul Wesley (DO #34-002939) – Avon, OH

Doctor's request for release from the terms of the 4/14/99 consent agreement granted by 7/9/08 Board vote. Release from probation effective 7/9/08.

PROBATION – MONITORING TERMS MODIFIED

ALLEN, David E. (MD #35-050640) – Pickerington, OH

Doctor's request to reduce required psychiatric sessions to every six months, eliminate required controlled substance log maintenance, and eliminate required chart review granted by 7/10/08 Board vote.

CARRAN, Todd S. (MD #35-070896) – Crestview Hills, KY

Monitoring physician approved and frequency and number of charts for review established by Board vote on 7/10/08.

STORROW, Alan B. (MD #35-060445) – Nashville, TN

Doctor's requests to reduce required alcohol and drug rehabilitation meetings to two per week, with a total of 10 per month, granted by 7/10/08 Board vote.

COURT ACTION UPDATE

ANSAR, Azber Azher (MD #35-078745) – Minneapolis, MN

By opinion rendered on 6/24/08 and entry filed on or about 7/2/08, the 10th District Court of Appeals affirmed the 12/7/07 Decision and Entry of the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, which had upheld the Board's 1/10/07 Order.

PARKS, Alan Joseph (MD #35-054686) – Columbus, OH

By opinion rendered on 6/30/08 and entry filed on or about 8/5/08, the 10th District Court of Appeals affirmed the 12/28/07 Decision and Entry of the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, which had upheld the Board's 3/14/07 Order.

Application for medical licensure denied based on applicant not having passed an acceptable exam sequence. (Journal Entry – no hearing requested) Order effective 7/9/08. **(Non-disciplinary)**

ROUSSI, Helene (LMT #33-005202) – Columbus, OH

Application for restoration of certificate to practice massage therapy granted, provided applicant takes and passes the limited branch portion of the massage therapy exam within six months of May 6, 2008. Based on applicant not have been engaged in the active practice of massage therapy for more than two years. (Journal Entry – no hearing requested) Order effective 7/9/08. **(Non-disciplinary)**

Voluntary Surrender

OLSEN, Margaret Mary (MD #35-047637) – Sylvania, OH

Doctor's permanent voluntary surrender of medical license accepted by Board vote on 7/9/08; doctor ineligible for licensure in the future. **(Non-disciplinary)**
