

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD OF OHIO, pursuant to CHAPTER 119. OHIO REVISED CODE, hereby gives notice that it will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of considering the adoption, amendment, and rescission rules.

The public hearing will be conducted on **Monday, June 19, 2006, beginning at 10:00 A.M., in Room 1932, Vern Riffe Center for Government and the Arts, 77 South High Street, 19th Floor, Columbus, OH.** Oral or written testimony may be presented by any person affected by the proposed action, his/her attorney, or both.

Pursuant to Section 119.032, ORC, the following rules are being proposed with no changes:
4731-22-03, 4731-22-04, and 4731-22-06, Ohio Administrative Code.

The following rule is proposed for amendment in order to facilitate care of hospice enrollees:

The following rules are proposed for amendment in order to clarify requirements:

- 4731-26-03 *Violations, miscellaneous* (pertaining to sexual misconduct)
- 4731-27-01 *Termination of physician-patient relationship*
