

**Application.**

Any practitioner duly licensed to practice medicine and surgery, osteopathic medicine and surgery, podiatric medicine and surgery, massage therapy, or cosmetic therapy in this state for at least ten years who declares that he or she is retired ~~in all jurisdictions~~ from active practice may apply to the board for emeritus registration. The practitioner may do so by indicating on his or her biennial registration form or in written correspondence to the Board ~~or by petitioning the board~~ if he or she is in fact ~~completely~~ retired and has not been the subject of disciplinary action in Ohio resulting in the revocation, suspension, probation, reprimand, or any other limitation of the physician's license to practice.
