

Voluntary compliance.

In any disciplinary ~~proceedings~~ proceeding brought by the board against a licensee alleging violations related to the practitioner's professional activities or mental or physical status while HIV or HBV infected, the licensee may offer evidence that he or she has voluntarily complied with an evaluation, monitoring, and any practice restrictions imposed by an ODH review panel, an institutional review panel approved by ODH, or the board, ~~and that~~ That evidence shall be considered by the board in deciding whether the practitioner has violated a statute upon which discipline may be based and, if it finds a violation, in deciding what, if any, discipline is appropriate ~~if it finds a violation.~~
