

**MEDICAL BOARD
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The **State Medical Board of Ohio**, pursuant to Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, hereby gives notice that it will conduct a public hearing to consider the rescission, amendment, and adoption of rules.

The public hearing will be conducted on **August 9, 2019, at 1:30 p.m. in the Lobby Hearing Room, Rhodes State Office Tower, 30 E. Broad St., 1st Floor, Columbus, OH.** Oral or written testimony may be presented by any person affected by the proposed actions.

The following rules are applicable to cosmetic therapy continuing education:

- 4731-1-08** Continuing cosmetic therapy education requirements for registration or reinstatement of a license to practice cosmetic therapy: *To be rescinded*
- 4731-1-08** Continuing cosmetic therapy education requirements for renewal, reinstatement, or restoration of a license to practice cosmetic therapy: *New rule*
